#### **Task Team on SBRs**

In March 2023 the UNSC approved the establishment of a single Task team on SBR to combine the activities of the two previous task teams:

- Task team on Exhaustive Business Registers
- Task team on Capacity Building



#### **New Mandate**

- Advance the methodological development of SBRs (especially taking into account evolving user needs and continuous innovation);
- Identify and develop tools to help countries to improve their SBRs, also aiming at leaving no on behind; and
- Share knowledge and country practices

- Quick preparation and circulating of the minutes




## Work done so far (some highlights)

- Finalized the Manual on the Maturity Model for Statistical Business Registers
  - An editorial group was established to
    - Review the comments from global consultation
    - Finalize the Self and Global assessment
- Developed the SIAP-ADB-UNSD E-learning course on SBRs
- Discussion on the OECD-UNSD Multinational Enterprise Information Platform (MEIP)



## Work done so far (some highlights)

- Discussions on the Global Initiative on Unique Identifiers for Businesses – endorsed by the UNSC in 2023
- Organized a Side Event at the UNSC in 2023 on the Global Initiative on Unique Identifiers for Businesses



- Close cooperation with TT-BDDE and TT-ITS
- Ongoing sharing of country practices



#### **Current areas of work**

- Preparing a report on the Integration of Geospatial Information in the SBR together with the Expert Group on the Integration of Geospatial and Statistical Information
- Ongoing development of the toolkit and website to support the Maturity Model for SBRs
- Review of the outcome of the global assessment on SBR
- Discussion on implementation issues in SBR with ISIC and NACE
- Follow up to global initiative
- Develop e-learning course on Profiling



#### Other areas of work

Other areas of work identified by the TT-SBR for a later stage include the following:


- Use of statistical units or institutional units
- Micro-data linking and SBR
- Guidance on protecting confidentiality when sharing MNE data
- Explore the use of Big Data and other alternative sources for SBR



#### **Self Assessment**

- Based on the maturity model
- For each dimension, a set of question to assess the stage of development







#### Global Assessment on the SBR

- Intended to be regularly conducted to
  - have a global overview of the status of implementation of SBR in counties
  - To identify priority areas for technical assistance and topics for further methodological guidance and future work
- Will be coordinated with the Country Progress Report of the Wiesbaden Group on Business Registers
- Will also include questions from the self assessment



#### Some issues

Frequency of the assessment

 Coordination with the country progress (to avoid response burden!!)

• Use of the responses: only reports at aggregate level? Individual responses made publicly available? etc.
