Integrated Environmental and Economic Accounts for Tradable Carbon Dioxide Emission Permits

The European Emissions Trading Scheme, which is part of the global carbon dioxide (CO₂) emission allowance market, constitutes a complex market for CO₂ permits.

In this paper, the Environmental-Economic Accounting framework is introduced as a tool for analysing both the physical and the monetary aspects of the permits as well as the permits flow through the economy.

Overall, the Environmental-Economic Accounting framework enables the user to make consistent analyses of the economic activity, consumption of energy, air emissions and the flow of CO_2 permits.
