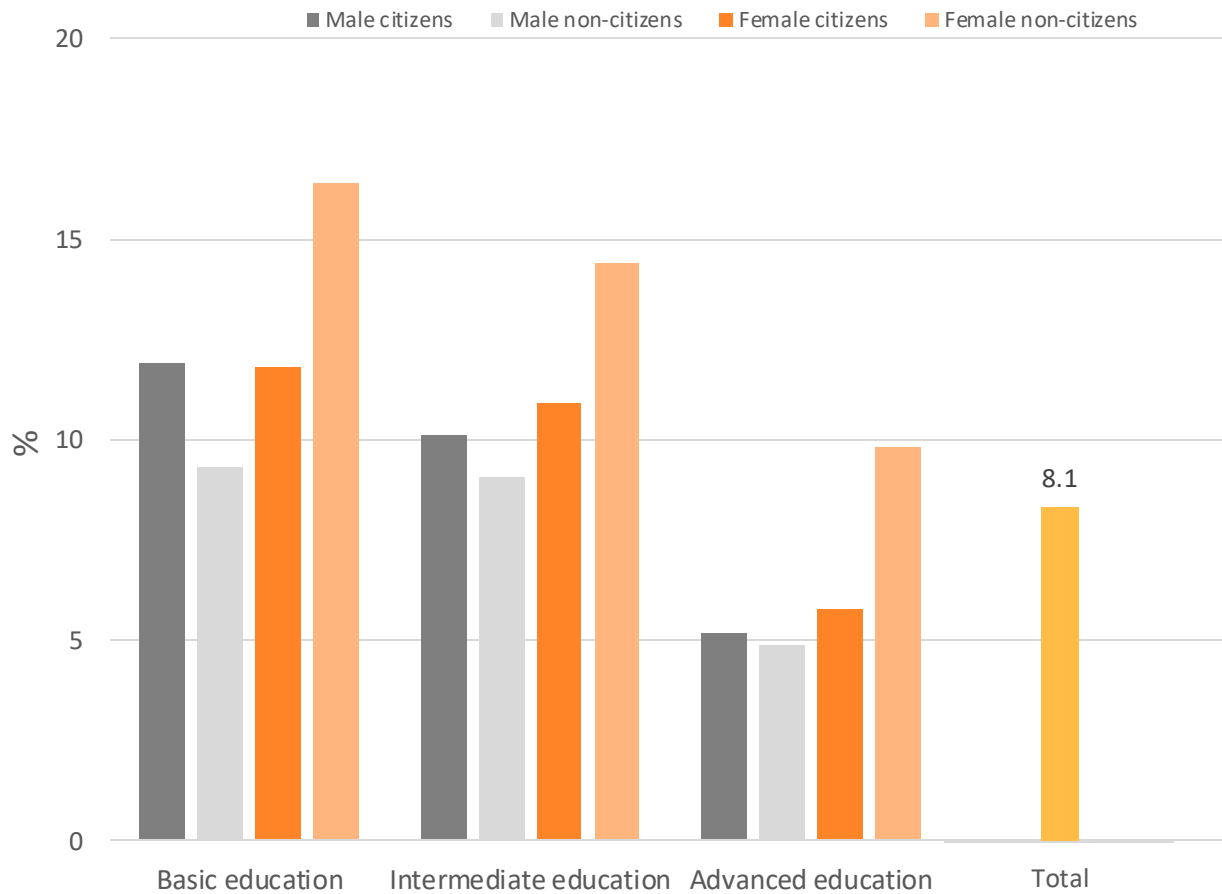

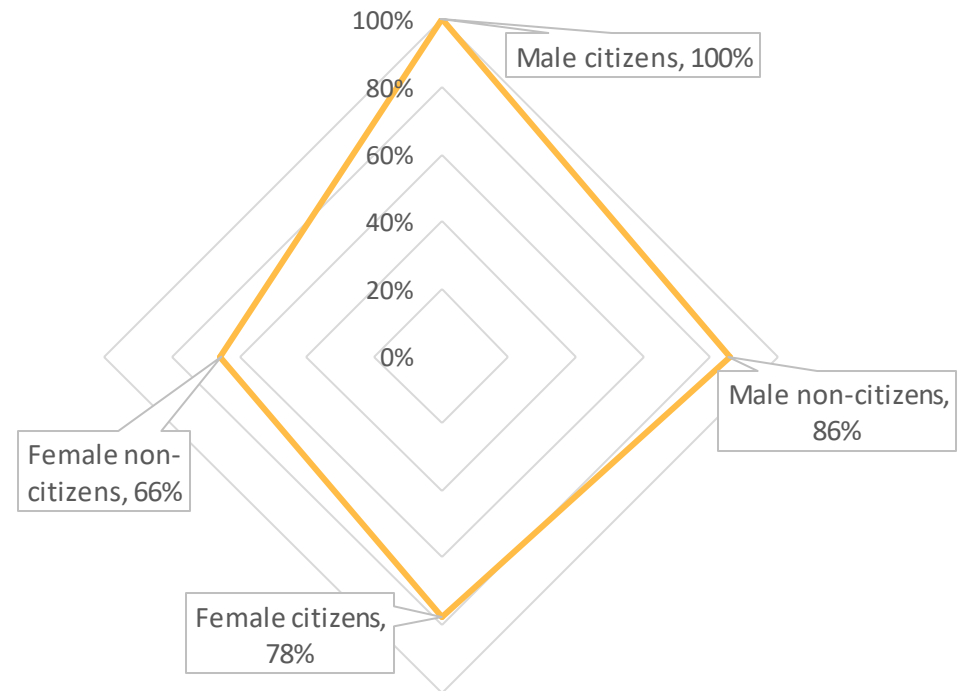

Unemployment rate, by sex, education and citizenship (%), 2020



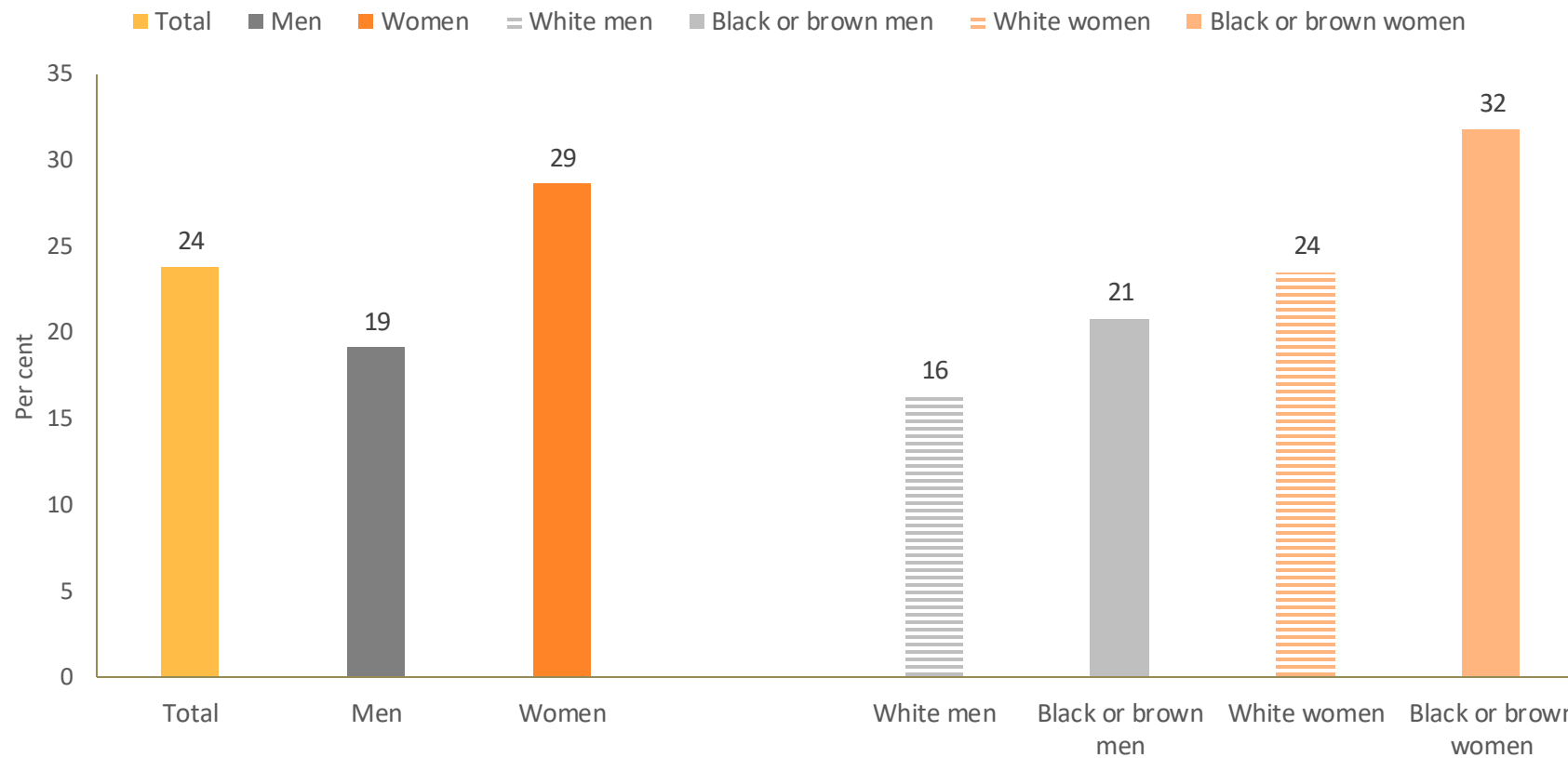
Ratio of monthly earnings of employees, by sex and citizenship

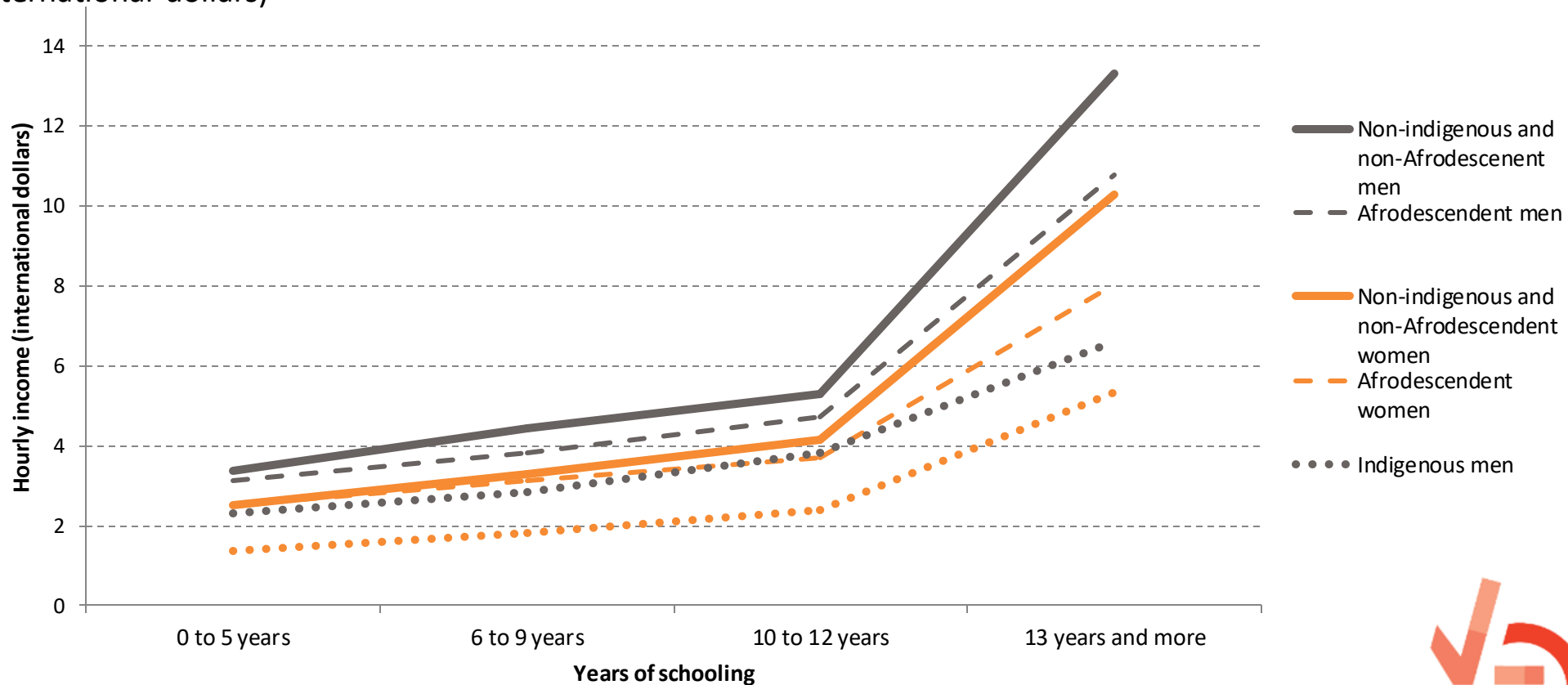
Share of the population not in employment, education or training by colour/race and by sex, 2018

(International dollars)

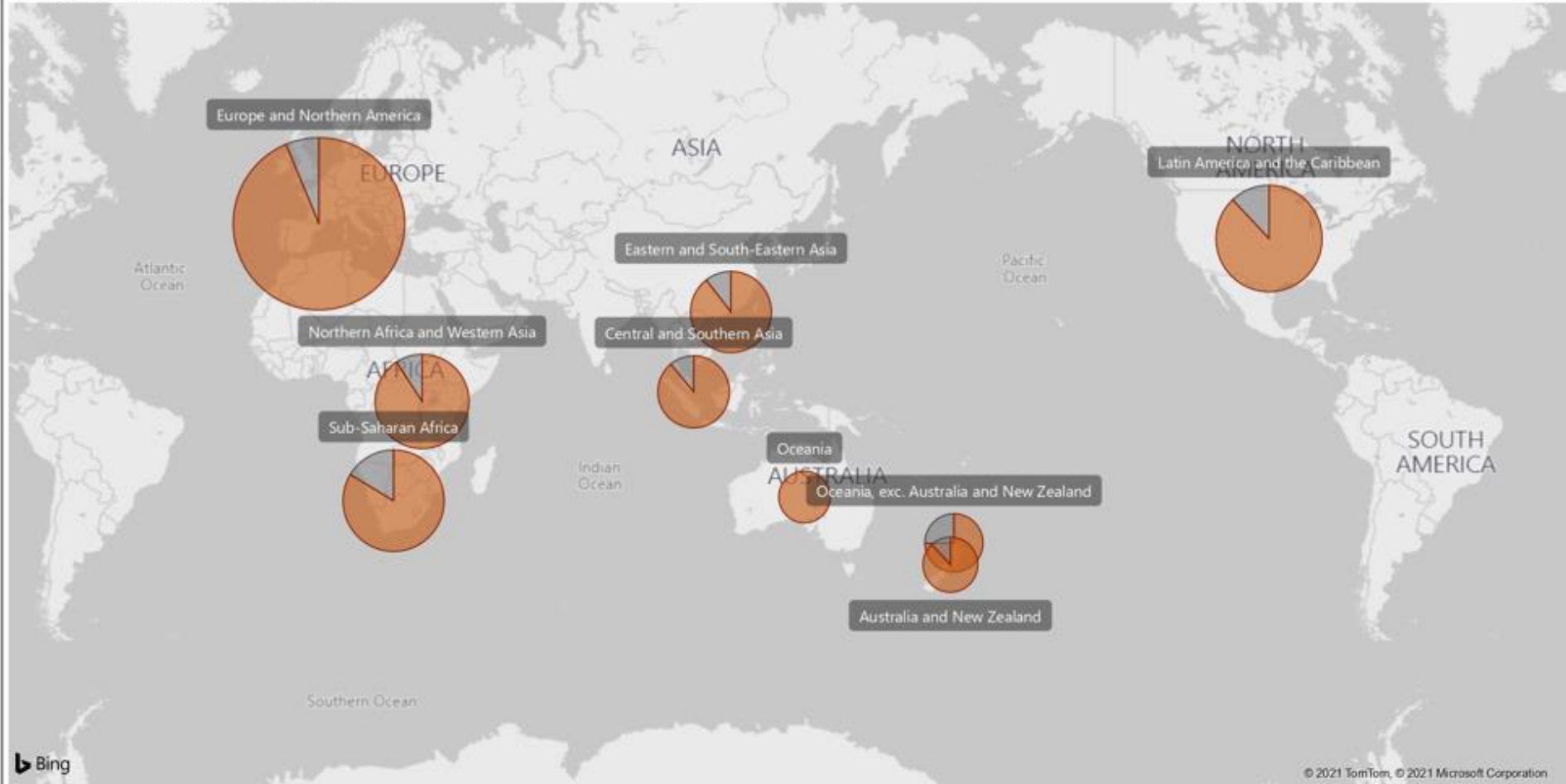

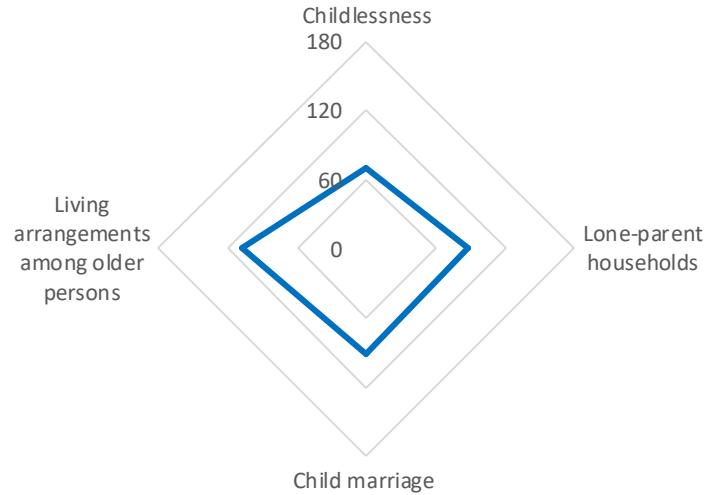

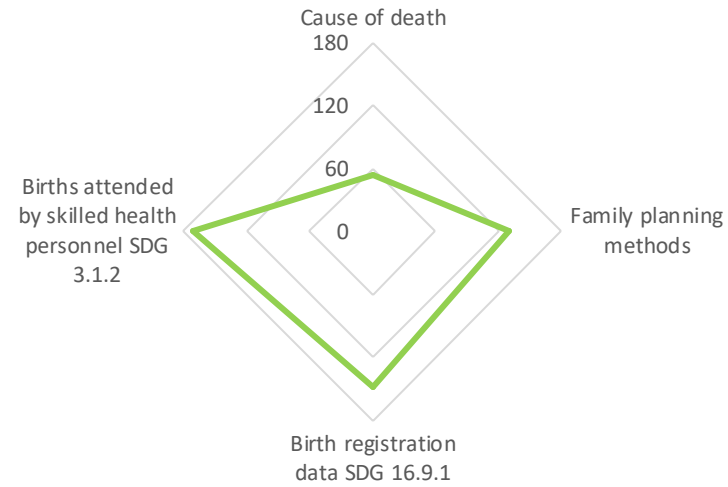

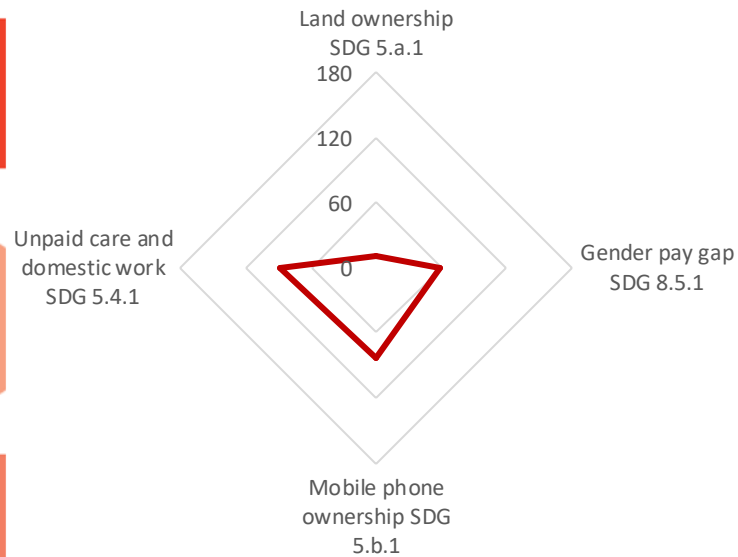

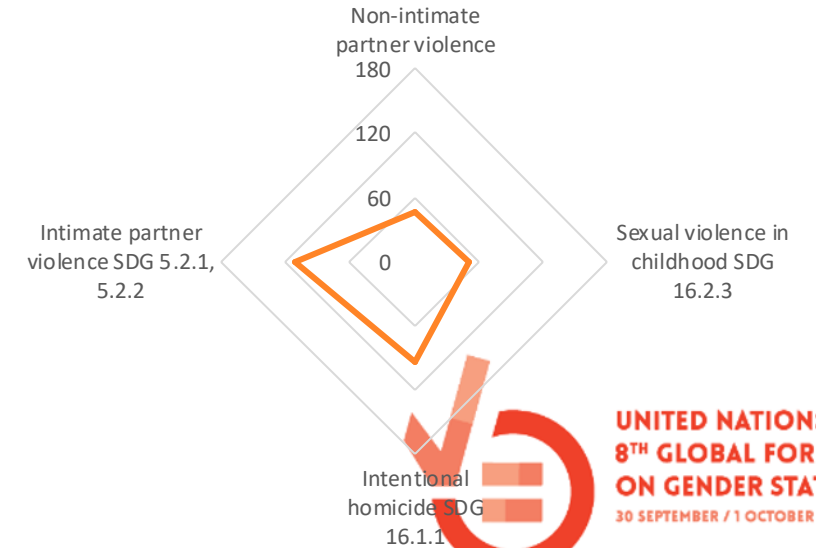

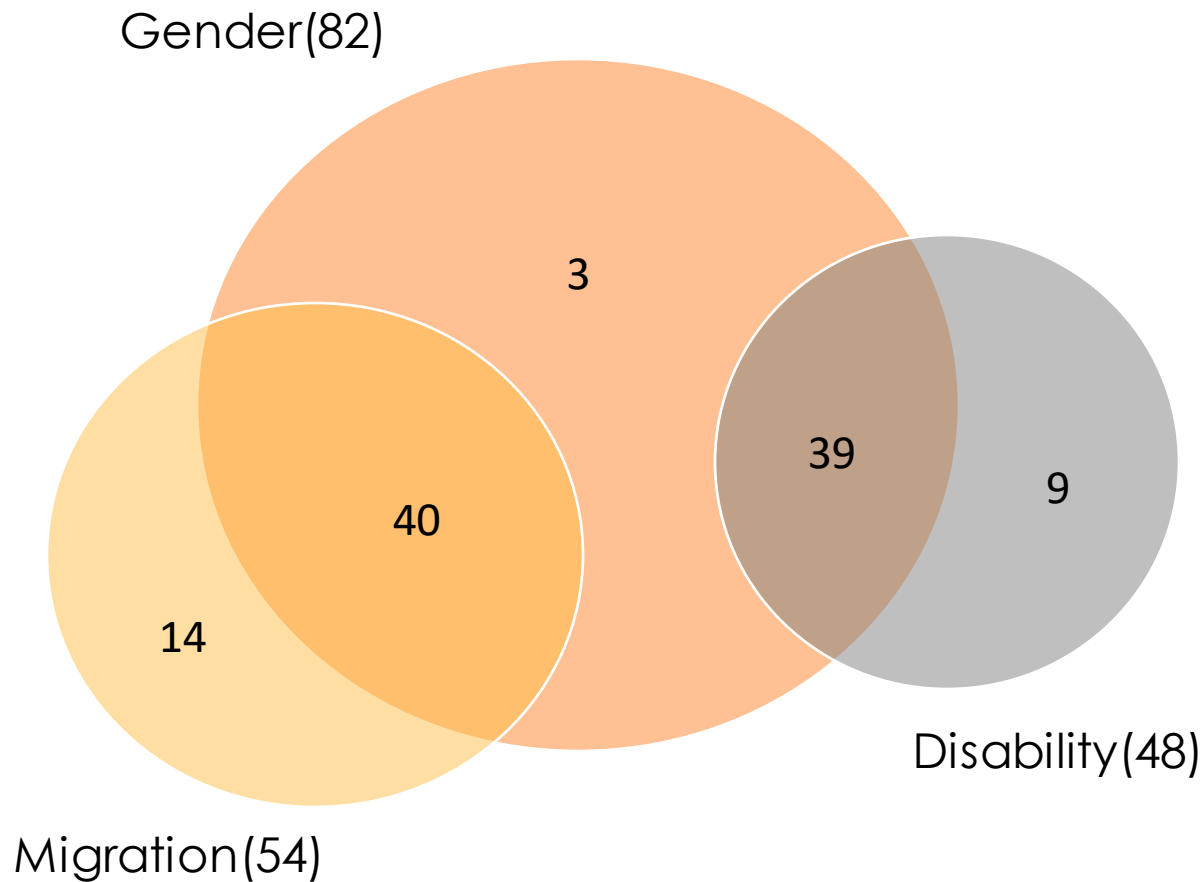
