

## Disability questions/items

- -ICD + ICF (f, s, a, p, e)
- -Different terms
- -E.g. seeing, sight, vision



# Issues for consideration for Global comparability -cont.

### Response categories

- yes/no
- severity scale (3 or 4 degrees)

### Other relevant items e.g.

- population coverage
- children
- institutionalized population
- homeless
- Ongoing stocktaking of questionnaires
- ICF mapping: identify differences and communalities
