Sustainable Development Goal target 10.7

Facilitate orderly, safe, regular and responsible migration and mobility of people, including through the implementation of planned and well-managed migration policies



Indicators of SDG target 10.7

- 10.7.1 Recruitment cost borne by employee as a proportion of yearly income earned in country of destination (World Bank)
- 10.7.2 Number of countries that have implemented well-managed migration policies (UN-DESA and IOM)

DESA-PD / IOM collaboration to develop the methodology and measurements for target **10.7.2**

- Concept and measure of “number of countries that have implemented well-managed migration policies” to be based on:
 - a) ‘Migration Governance Framework’ (IOM Council, November 2015), and
 - b) The UN Inquiry among governments on Population and Development (UN-DESA)

Summary timeline

- June-December 2017: Validation and testing of the methodology, including country consultations;
- Summer 2018: Data collected, database generated and basic results presented;
- Fall 2018-Spring 2019: Request for graduation from tier III, validated data integrated into analytical outputs (reports, briefs, fact sheets, etc.), in anticipation of the 2019 HLPF review of goal 10.
