 - Migratory administrative records

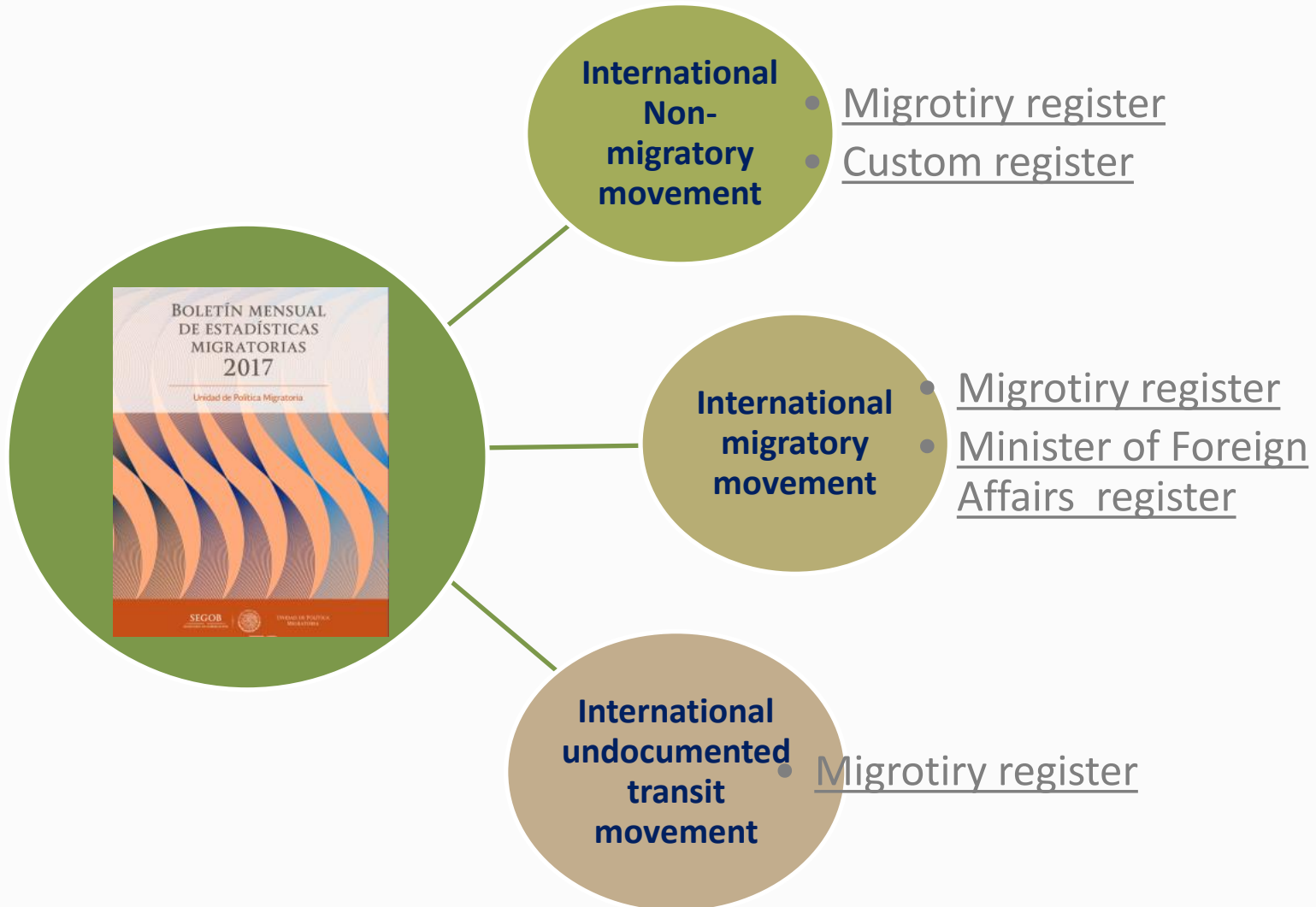
- c) Regular residence

- b) Flows: events of occurrence

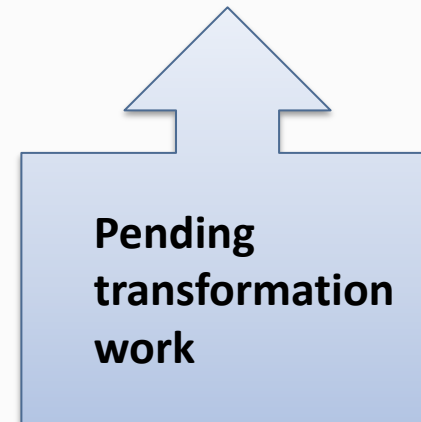
THE ADMINISTRATIVE MIGRATORY RECORDS

¿Which information is available?

- a) Information by sex
- b) Age desegregated (individually)
- c) Migratory condition (residence permit)
- d) Civil status
- e) Level of education (at the time of the procedure)
- f) State and municipality of previous residence in Mexico

¿Information that is missing and needs to be generated?

- a) Occupation,
- b) Main activity,
- c) Situation at work,
- d) Work experience
- e) Work destination in Mexico



AREAS OF OPPORTUNITY

- To advance in the integration of comparable questions or categories between censuses, surveys and administrative records.
- Establish the conceptual definition of terms for the exchange of information through the establishment of a standardized methodological criteria.
- Generation of **techniques and instruments** to measure flows at land borders of **high mobility** and cross-border live.

COMMENTS ON UN PROPOSED INDICATORS

- In general the Migration Policies Unit from the Minister of Interior in Mexico agrees on the importance of 19 of the 26 proposed indicators by the UN.
- There are 7 indicators that we do not see as necessary directly related to the integration of migrants in Mexico.
- It is important to mention that from the 19 indicators that we consider relevant to measure the integration of migrants in Mexico, we internally as a Country will need to discuss and agree on several points that will allow us to determinate if we are in a position of having or develop all the information we need to generate the indicators on a regular basis (conceptual, available information, national security, etc.).
