Abstract:

The Statistics Bureau of Japan conducted the Survey on Time Use and Leisure Activities in October 2016. The Survey aims to obtain comprehensive data on daily patterns of time allocation and on leisure activities and has been conducted every five years since 1976. This presentation will introduce how the survey has evolved over time on unpaid work about this survey. In addition, it will show the trend of the result of the past 20 years.
