## Experiences in producing data according to 19<sup>th</sup> ICLS and on communication strategies adopted to explain the impact of methodological changes on labour indicators

The new working definitions proposed by the 19<sup>th</sup> CIET were incorporated into the new Brazilian household sample survey - the PNAD Continuous, whose data series began in 2012 and definitively replaced the previous research (PNAD) from 2016. The Brazilian experience shows that some important adaptations in questionnaire were necessary, including some questions of coverage that facilitated the understanding of the different forms of work. The comparison between the historical series of the PNAD and Continuous PNAD, however, cannot be exclusively attributed to the conceptual changes, considering that other methodological changes also interfere in the direct comparison of the indicators.
