Programme objectives:

- 1. Enabling policy environment: Putting in place an enabling environment for a gender-responsive localization and effective monitoring of national and international policy commitments;
- 2. Data production: Filling gender data gaps by ensuring that quality and comparable gender statistics are produced regularly; and
- **3.** Data use: Ensuring that gender statistics are accessible and used to inform policy and advocacy.

- BGD LoA to be signed next week to begin implementation with BBS and MOW.
- Asia and the Pacific (AP) Committee on Statistics supported the following proposals:
 - UNW to become a formal member of Committee's thematic workstreams
 - UNW to lead the needs assessment and subsequent process for the establishment of an inter-governmental group on Gender Statistics.
 - Plans: Workshop on Pacific Roadmap on Gender Statistics (11-15 Feb 2019) with SPC and ESCAP Pacific Office





- NPL Co-facilitated with WB and CBS technical sessions on methodological aspects of Time Use Surveys.
- Asia and the Pacific (AP) -
 - Established a Subgroup on gender statistics training (within the Network for the coordination of statistical training in SIAP)
 - TOR finalized
 - Representatives from training institutes, NSOs, CSOs, Ministries
 - Technical support for survey data analysis in select countries upon request (Pakistan)
 - Plans: Workshop on data integration and disaggregation with UNSD, UNICEF and ESCAP-SD (28-31 Jan 2019)
 - *Plans*: Support TUS in select countries in 2019 (Bangladesh, Nepal, Cambodia)





- NPL Facilitated a user-producer dialogue with 150+ participants on the role of CSOs in gender statistics.
- Asia and the Pacific (AP)
 - Organized and facilitated with SIAP the 7th Workshop on Forging Partnerships for Statistical Training in Asia and the Pacific.
 - Plans: Hands-on training on SDMX for gender data exchanges with UNSD (10-14 Dec 2018)
 - Plans: Hands-on training and user-producer dialogue on communicating and visualizing data with ESCAP-SD (27-31 May 2019)
