


Population censuses 2001 – 2010

Years 2008 - 2017





## What are the elements of a Global Programme Ecuador would benefit from the most?

#### Build and strengthen national capacities to produce migration statistics

Assessing national needs for capacity-building

- Identify gaps in data production (traditional data sources)
- Identify new data sources (non-traditional)
- Identify needs for training on data analysis

Harmonizing methodologies for data collection

- Test and use standard questions on international migration for 2020 census
- Introduce standard questions and sampling strategies in future surveys

Integrating traditional data

- Use a framework to integrate administrative data
- 2. Learn from other countries experiences integrating traditional data
- 3. Legal framework

Introducing non-traditional data sources (big data)

- How to share business data with the statistical office?
- 2. Integrate traditional sources and big data in order to improve migration data

### Global Programme for Migration Data

#### Outcomes expected

- Measure the stocks and flows of migrants
- Measure accurately the number and characteristics of migrants
  - Vulnerable groups of migrants (refugees, children, etc.)
  - Migrants with irregular status
  - Data at subnational level
  - Migration estimates
- Dissemination and communication strategy
- Evaluate the impact of migration in the national and local economy
- Measure the public service capacity for immigrants necessities
- Report SDG indicators related to migration
- Analyze and use migration data for public policy
- Collaboration between relevant stakeholders at national and international level.
- Measure return migration statistics
