## Moroccan experiences

- National Time Use Survey (NTUS) 1997 (targeting only women - 2800 women)
- NTUS 2011-2012 (targeting women, men and children)
- Sample size households:
  - -8 990 households,
  - 15 486 women and men (+ 15 y)
  - 2851 child (7 to14 y).

## Methodology

- Collection instrument: Full diary
- -Time use classification: Trial ICATUS 2005 and HETUS 2008 contextualized to national needs
- All days of the week are well represented
- Reference period for recorded activities: Previous day
- Time interval in diary: 24-hourperiod diary with Open interval time (beginning /ending time and duration (hours /minutes) for each activity)
- Survey duration: 12 months to capture seasonal variations in activities, the school calendar and variations related to religion
- Data collection mode: Paper

## **National classification (1)**

- Four levels hierarchical classification composed of 9 major divisions -
- 43 divisions 100 groups and 620 classes of activities (4 digits);

## **National classification (2)**

- The "travel time" classification of the trip is based on the means used and the nature of the activity for which it is carried out.
- The "waiting time" related to a given activity has been coded in the associated activity group.

## **Additional information**

- To interpret time use patterns:
- Education levels, employment status, type of employment, and household structure...
- Specificity of the day (normal day, special day, partial work day, free day (no work/ holiday), Weekly Market Day)
- Presence of domestic workers
- -Availability of household equipment (dishwasher, washing machine ...)
- Interhousehold transfers of services (received from family, friends, neighbors..., duration (H, min))

## Contextual variables related to the activity

**Location**: Where the respondents are when the activity accured:

- 1. At home
- 2: At someone else's home
- 3. At school
- 4. At work place (excluding home)
- 5. Mobile Workplace
- 6. Public places (Restaurant/café, Mosque, Hospital...)
- 7. Other place



## **Contextual variables related to the activity**

With whom: presence of other people when the activity occured (care services or not)

- 1. On my own
- 2. Spouse

#### NACTUS 2011-2012/ ICATUS 2016: main differencies

## **Employment**

NACTUS 2011/12 does not allow to differentiate:

- Employment in corporation government and non-profit institutions from employment in household enterprises
- Between activities production of goods or services for own final use from those for pay or profit or for market
- Activities related to setting up a business
- Unpaid Trainee work and related activities

#### **Domestic and care services**

- Unpaid domestic/services care for family members is considered as a voluntary work for other households like neighbors, friends...

To be capture in the next rebasing, NTUS 2020/2021 which will adopt ICATUS 2016

## Challenges related to the data collection mode

- Respondents have difficulty to memorize with accuracy the time spend on the activity (beginning and ending time) because of the illiteracy or the lack and limited use of timepieces at home and the perception of time that differs according to people: age, and sociocultural contexts.
- we try to help them to remember the time of beginning or end of the activity by referring to some usual time references such as the calling time prayer, broadcast times of some popular TV or radio programs or time of departure or return to/from work or school of some household member ...
- In simultanous activities, the duration of an activity reported by the respondent as a secondary is longer than the duration of the primary activity, in which case the first one is considered as a primary activity.



#### Difficulty related to contextual information

- For whom: Difficulty to specify the motivation behind some confused activities E.g., Palying with child, conversation with others, reception (for own pleasure or for others?)

E.g., fishing, garding... kind of activities done for own use and for own pleasure at the same time

E.g., When a home help practices an unpaid professional work, is this activity regarded as made for the family or against a benefit?

 The question "With whom?" Must be well defined to be able to distinguish whether the other person should participate or not in the declared activity even if passively.

#### Difficulty related to instrument mode

- To measure the effective time spent on professional work
- To distinguish the time dedicated to production for own use from that dedicated to production intended for the market
