# Current Birth Registration – 2019 v 2020

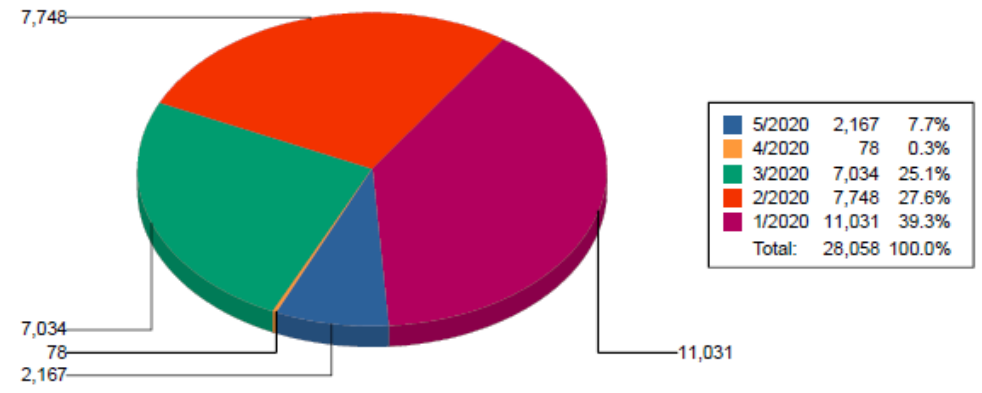
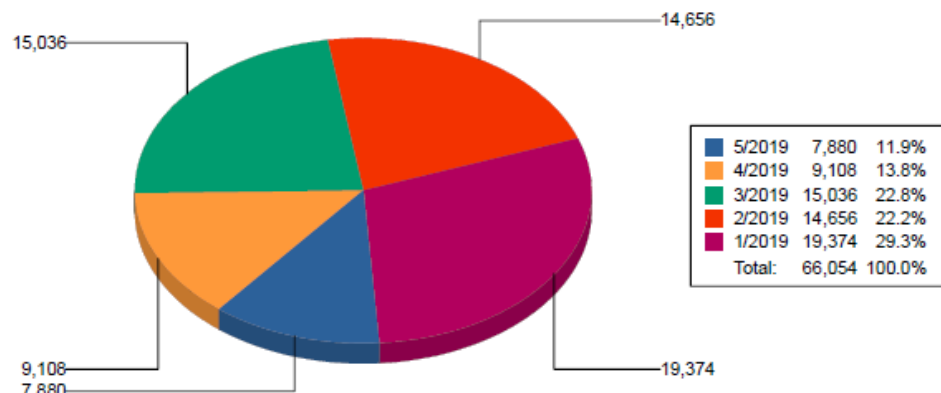

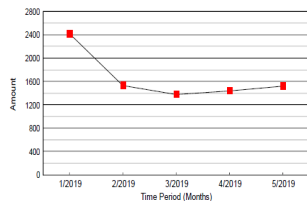
During the same period, the Office was no longer accepting application due to covid 19 pandemic

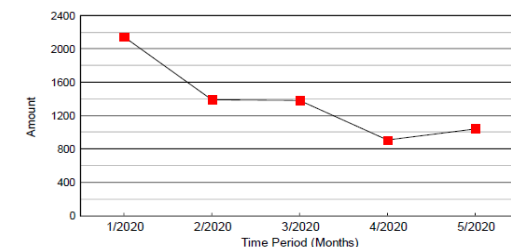
There was a noticeable drop in April 2020. When one examines CoD for Lesotho, this may be because of the lockdown.

### REDUCTION OF WORKING HOURS

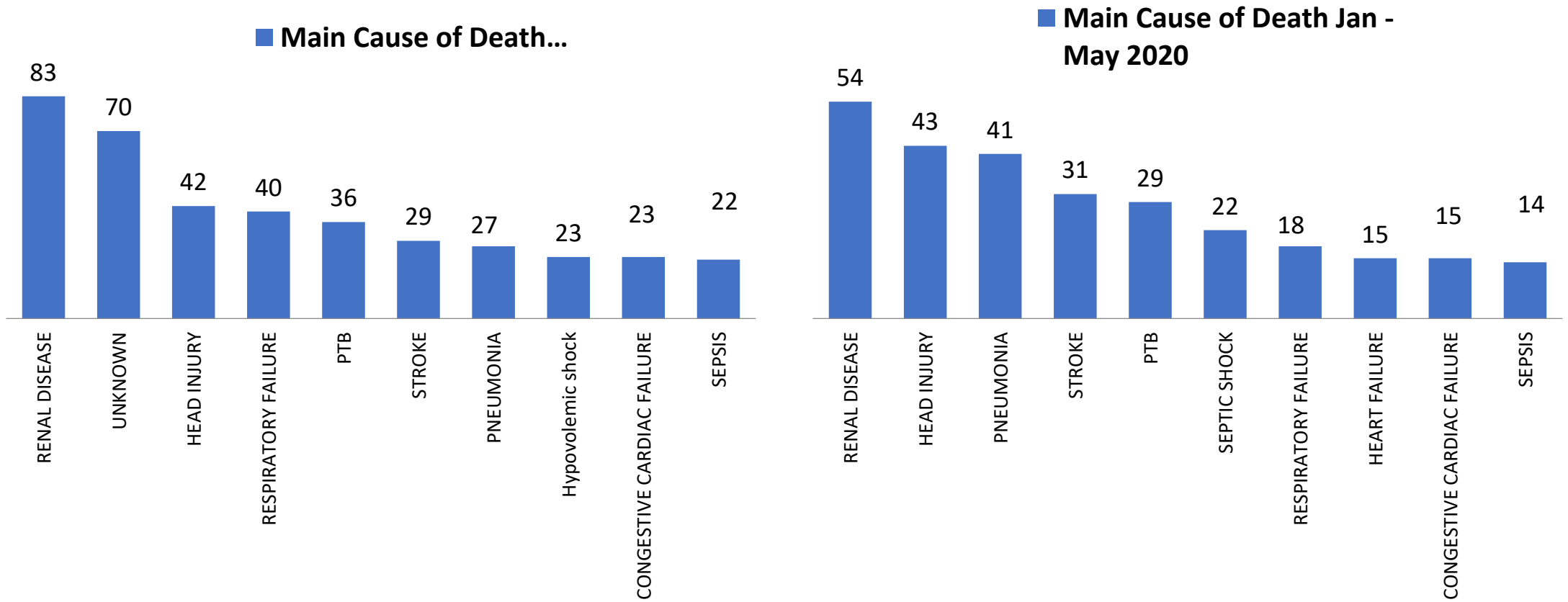
The next slide examines CoD, while the country has not yet reported case of Covid 19 – death, there is a slide increase of deaths reported due to PNEUMONIA
