Demographic Statistics in Israel and DYB



Data Sources:

Last census, Population register, Vital registration, Border reg., migration reg., Address moves reg., Institution census.

Data (of previous year) Processing:

April to June: editing, imputation, Anchoring addresses

July: DB for dissemination

Since August: official publications, serving users, international reporting.

February-April: (next year): DYB

Issues for discussion



- Should there be full compatibility between the data published by the NSO's and the data published by international organizations/DYB?
- Do we want to access the data once to all the international organizations?

Issues for discussion (con.)



- Is the accessibility of the data of all countries, should be at the same time (simultaneous)?
- Is the traditional framework of DYB necessary? Is accessing the data through a database enough?
- Is it necessary to expand the list of indices for international comparison? (cohort indices)

Modernizing the process?



- Prepare, in each issue (population, births,
 deaths, marriages, divorce, ...) a PUF that
 serves all the needs of international
 organizations (For example, population file by age, sex, urban
 / rural, city of residence, etc.)
- Access the files on the website (or in any other technological way)
