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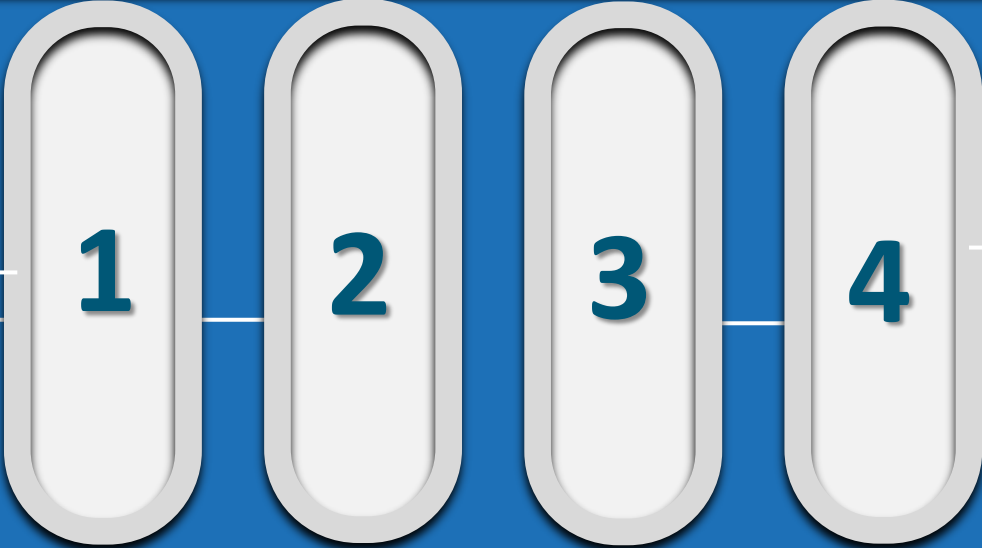

# NEW PLAN FOR INDONESIA'S POPULATION CENSUS 2020



## WHO

All **population** living or will be living in Indonesia **for at least 1 year**



## WHERE

**All Indonesia's territories**

(Including Indonesian representatives or missions who are living abroad)



## WHEN

- ✓ **Phase 1: Full enumeration**
  - a. **Online census**  
(15 February – 31 March 2020)  
**29 May 2020**
  - ~~b. Face-to-face enumeration~~  
(~~1 – 31 July 2020~~)
  - b. Ground check and Self Filling Questionnaire**  
**1 – 30 September 2020**
- ✓ **Phase 2: Indepth Survey (2021)**



## METHOD

### “Combined Census”

Using administrative data as pre-list as the basis for Population Census

### THREE TWO MODES OF COLLECTION:

 **CAWI** (Computer Aided Web Interviewing)

 **CAPI** (Computer Aided Personal Interviewing)

 **PAPI** (Paper and Pencil Interviewing)

# COMBINED CENSUS

Integration of population data on PC2020 with administrative population data.



Data collection of PC2020:  
12 variables can be found at population register data



- ✓ *Name*
- ✓ *Person ID*
- ✓ *Family ID*
- ✓ *Registered Address*
- ✓ *Sex*
- ✓ *Place and Date of Birth*
- ✓ *Nationality*
- ✓ *Religion*
- ✓ *Relation to the head of family*
- ✓ *Marital Status*
- ✓ *Education*
- ✓ *Job*

# IMPACT OF ADJUSTMENT ON OUTPUTS

## Zone 1 & 3

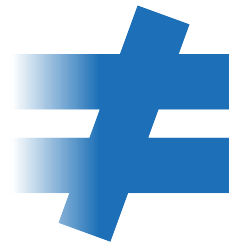
- ✓ Sex

### Outputs from Short Form Quest (2020)

- ✓ Housing characteristics: **5 questions**
- ✓ Individual characteristics all ages: **13 questions**
- ✓ Individual characteristics 5+: **17 questions**



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# Several Adjustments in PC2020

## 01 The time reference in Population Concept

- ✓ Law no. 24 of 2013 Article 14: the resident is someone who has been domiciled for more than one year or based on the needs of the person concerned for less than 1 (one) year.
- ✓ United Nations Statistics Division recommends that countries apply a threshold of 12 months when considering the place of usual residence.
- ✓ For those reasons, the time reference in the PC2020 in Indonesia is adjusted to 12 months threshold (The previous PC used the 6 months threshold)
- ✓ How to bridge the 12 months concept to the concept that used in previous censuses?



## 02 Statistical Working Area (WILKERSTAT)



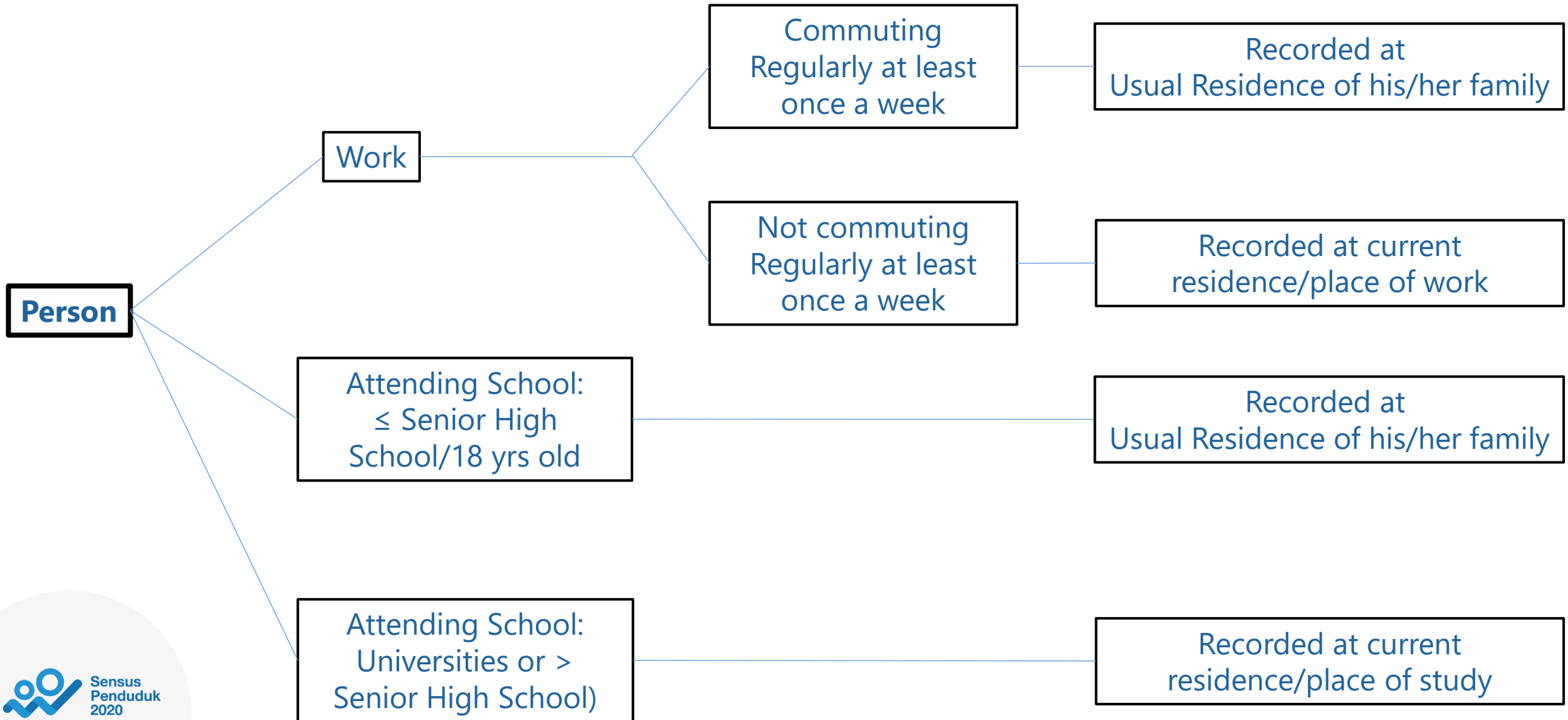
Census block replaced with Local Neighborhood Unit (SLS)

How to bridge SLS to Census Block → for sampling frame of socioeconomic survey in BPS

## 03 Household and Family Concepts



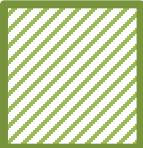

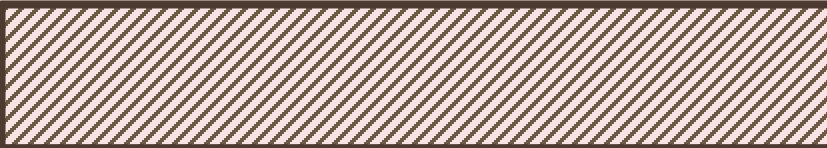
- ✓ In the previous population censuses, the enumeration unit used to calculate the population was using the household approach.
- ✓ PC2020 will utilize administrative data, so the enumeration unit will need to be adjusted using a family approach based on population documents, Registered Family Card (KK).
- ✓ How to bridge family to household concept → for sampling frame of socioeconomic survey in BPS

# REGISTERED VS USUAL RESIDENCE





# POPULATION DATA

Condition	Administrative Data	Census Data (Based on PC2020)
Registered Residence = Usual Residence		
Registered Residence ≠ Usual Residence		
Usually reside population but unidentified in administrative data (No PID Info)		
Registered in the pre-list/administrative data but unidentified in the field (No longer stay at registered residence/move/unknown, died)		<b>HIGH POTENTIAL OF OVERLAPPING DATA / DOUBLE DATA (NEED FURTHER CONSOLIDATION)</b>

# SOME THOUGHTS...



Do we have another terms for *de-facto vs de-jure*?

- *Registered-residence*
- *Usual-residence*
- *On site-residence*

Is it possible to exchange information on how many “foreigners” living in a country?

- **Add one question: people by nationalities reside in a country at a particular time period.**
