




Quick Fact

There are 6.271 employed persons in the municipality; the unemployment rate is estimated at 17,3%, which does not include the 372 discouraged work-seekers who have given up looking for work. Amongst the youth in the area, 2.725 are employed; the youth unemployed rate is estimated at 22,7%, which does not include the 244 youth who fall within the discouraged work-seeker group.

















Audience reach: potential number of people reached by our content/content mentioning Stats SA








- Discoverability through the website and social media
- Metadata compiled by survey area and released as part of online tools in PDF format and forms part of the quality enhancement process. This can include questionnaire as well as description of fields and categories. Can include methodological and technical notes
- Important to release metadata for reasons of transparency and to enhance research





#### Recommendation for DYB

- Avail pre-publication copy to NSO for checking of data
- Send hard or electronic copy of DYB to NSO for further dissemination amongst local stakeholder and by placing link on NSO website
- Avail customised excel files by theme similar to WPP
- Make available metadata collected from NSO for each section of the DYB
