## Questionnaires

- Six questionnaires were used in census enumeration;
  - Main questionnaire:- for enumerating all persons found in conventional households;
  - Hybrid questionnaire (group quarters):- for enumerating all persons living in collective dwelling units.

## Questionnaires .....

- The four short questionnaires enumerated:-
  - ✓ Hotel/lodge residents, hospital in-patients, prison/police cells and children homes
  - ✓ Travelers and persons on transit;
  - ✓ Street persons/outdoor sleepers/ vagrants
  - ✓ Emigrants in the last 15 years (linked to main questionnaire)

## Main Questionnaire

Main questionnaire covered the following thematic areas;

- ▶ **Demographic** (age, sex, relationships, marriage, migration, fertility, mortality);
- ▶ **Socio-economic** (marital status, religion, ethnicity, education, labour participation, ICT, agriculture, Assets);
- ▶ **Household and housing characteristics** (floor/roof/wall materials, tenure status, dwelling units, sources of water, energy and waste disposal);
- ▶ **Emigration**

## Census basic reports

1. Volume I: Distribution of population by size, sex, number of households and average household size, at national, county and sub-county levels
2. Volume II: Distribution of Population by Administrative units (up to Sub-Locational level)
3. Volume III: Distribution of Population by Age and Sex
4. Volume IV: Distribution of Population by Socio-Economic Characteristics
5. Volume V: Distribution of Population by Geopolitical Units (**Not Yet Published**)

# Introduction to Population Projections



- ❑ **Components of Population Change**
  - ❑ **Births:** The number of live births in a given period.
  - ❑ **Deaths:** The number of deaths in a given period.
  - ❑ **Migration:** The movement of people into (immigration) or out of (emigration) an area.

# Uses of Population Projections



11

1. **Distribution of resources-** Future changes in size, Composition , Distribution of the population
2. **Advocacy-**
  - a) Develop effective policies that foster education and economic opportunities;
  - b) Adapt social sector spending to the changing age structure;
  - c) Providing social support and health care for the elderly population
3. **Research-** Future growth in working age population and school going population
4. **Monitoring and evaluation-** Denominators used during target setting and ME, especially at impact level

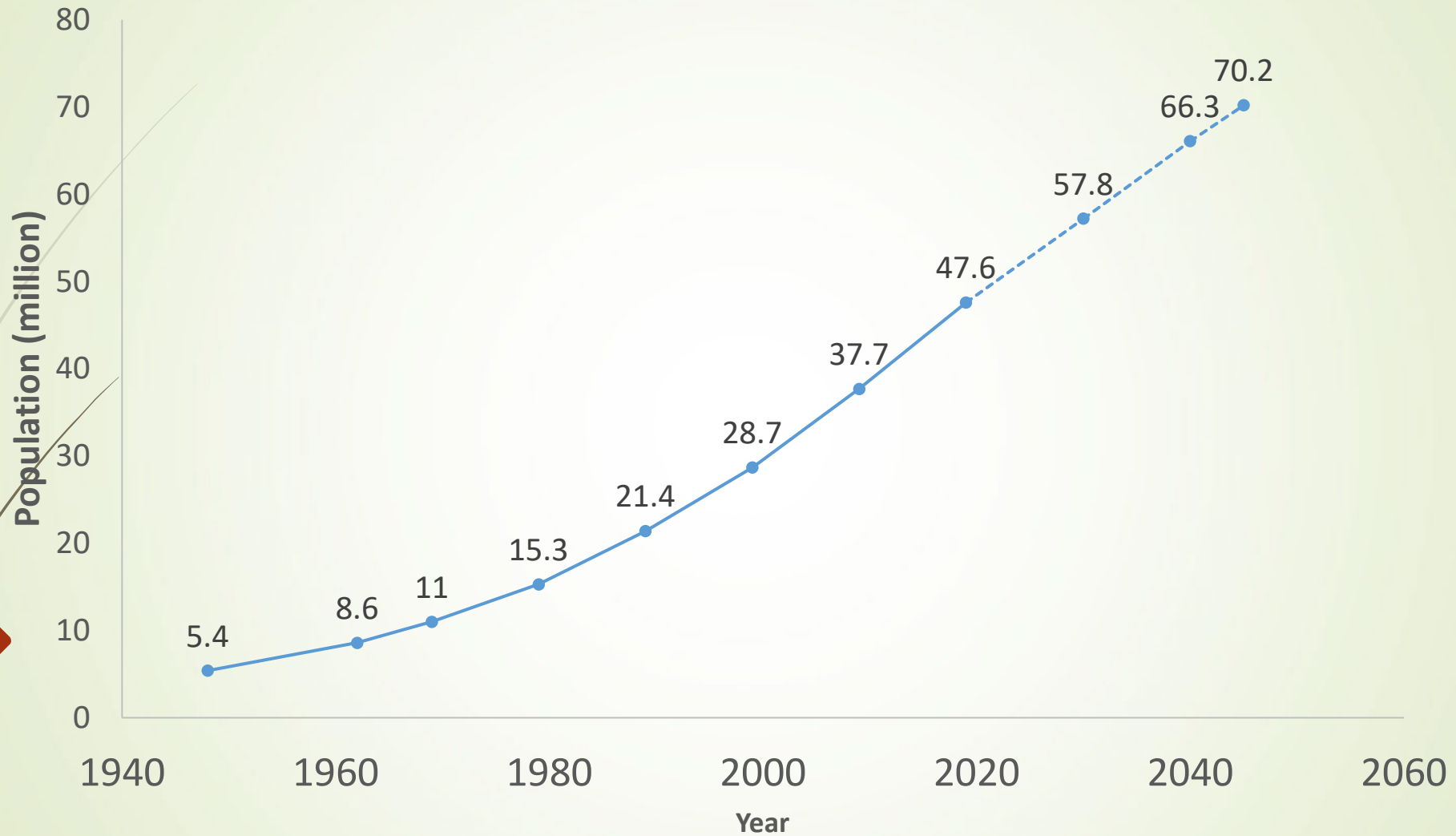

# Population Projections

- ❑ The projected population is expected to increase from 48.8 million in 2020,
  - 53.3 million by 2025,
  - 57.8 million by 2030,
  - 62.2 million by 2035,
  - 70.2 million by 2045

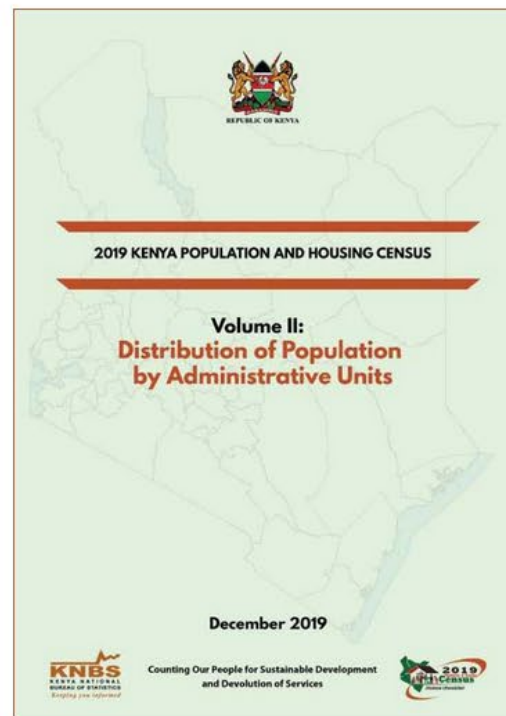

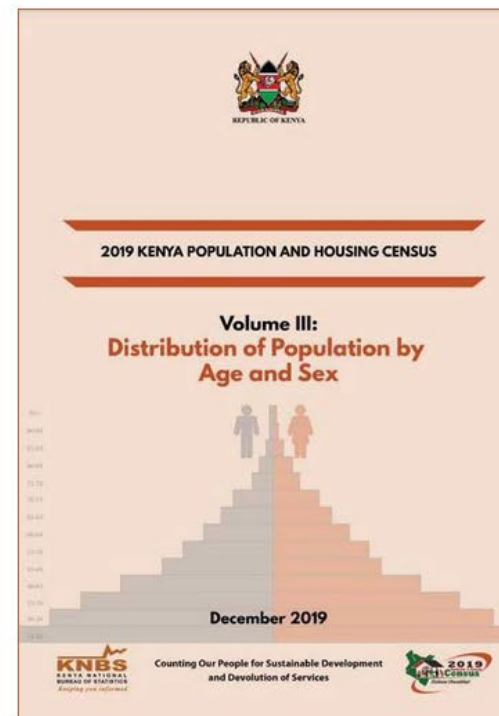

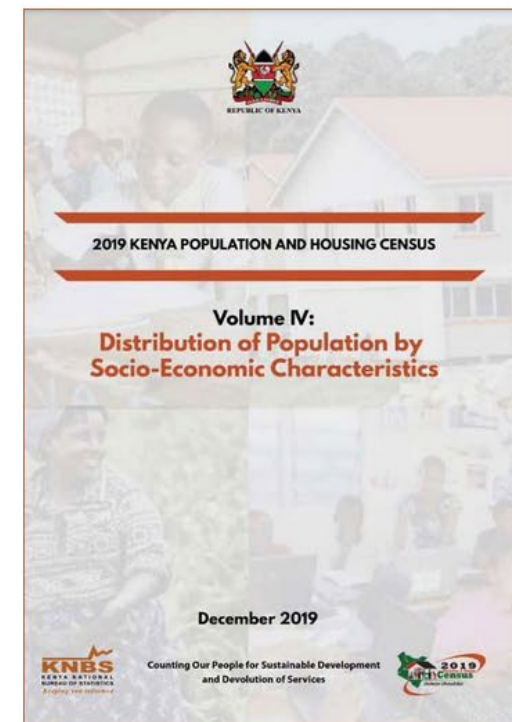
**KPHC Volume 1 Population By County And Sub County**

**KPHC Volume 3 Distribution of Population by Age and Sex**

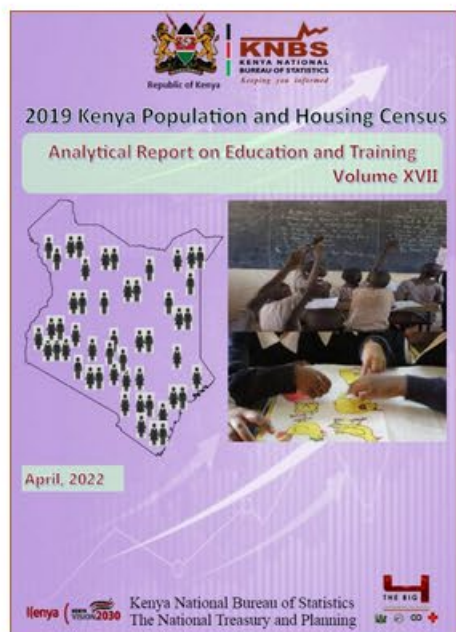

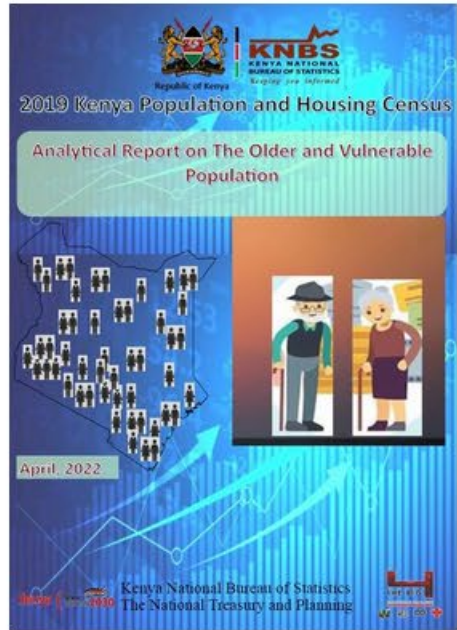
