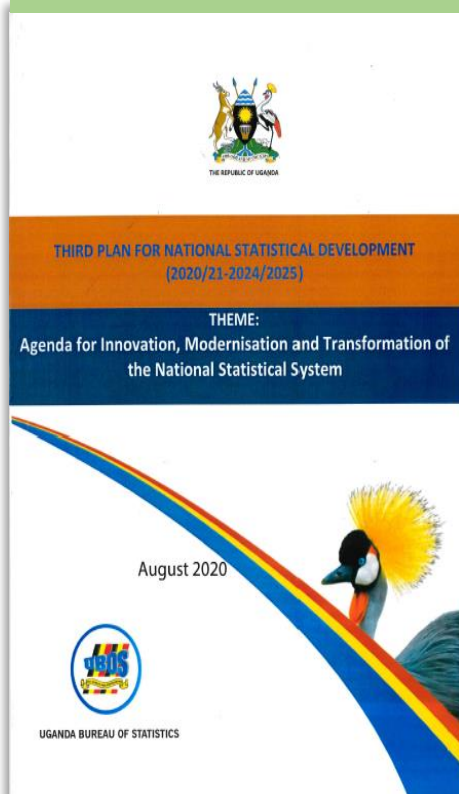

- National Population and Housing Census (NPHC) 2024
- Conducted in May 2024
- Collected various demographic and socio-economic characteristics of the population
- 1st Digital, 6th Post-Independence and 11th Census in the country.

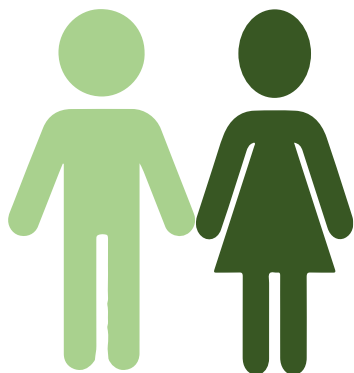
Introduction...



- De-facto
- Digital maps for enumeration areas
- Male and female interviewers, ensuring no gender bias
- Local interviewers recruited from areas of operation ensuring no language or cultural biases

Information collected

✓ Sex of individuals:



- Male
- Female

Sex is the basic variable for gender statistics, but not all.

Information collected...



- ✓ Access to resources:
- Saving schemes
 - *Banks, Mobile money, SACCOs, etc*
 - Mobile phone
 - *Ownership and use (including for transactions)*
 - Other ICT
 - *Computer, internet*
 - Land, including title deed
 - *Alone or Jointly*
 - Government Programmes
 - *Grants for Special groups*

✓ Socio-economic status:

- Age
- Religion
- Tribe
- Marital status
- Education status
- Migration and Forced Displacement status
- Disability and mental health status
- Labour force status
- Emigration status

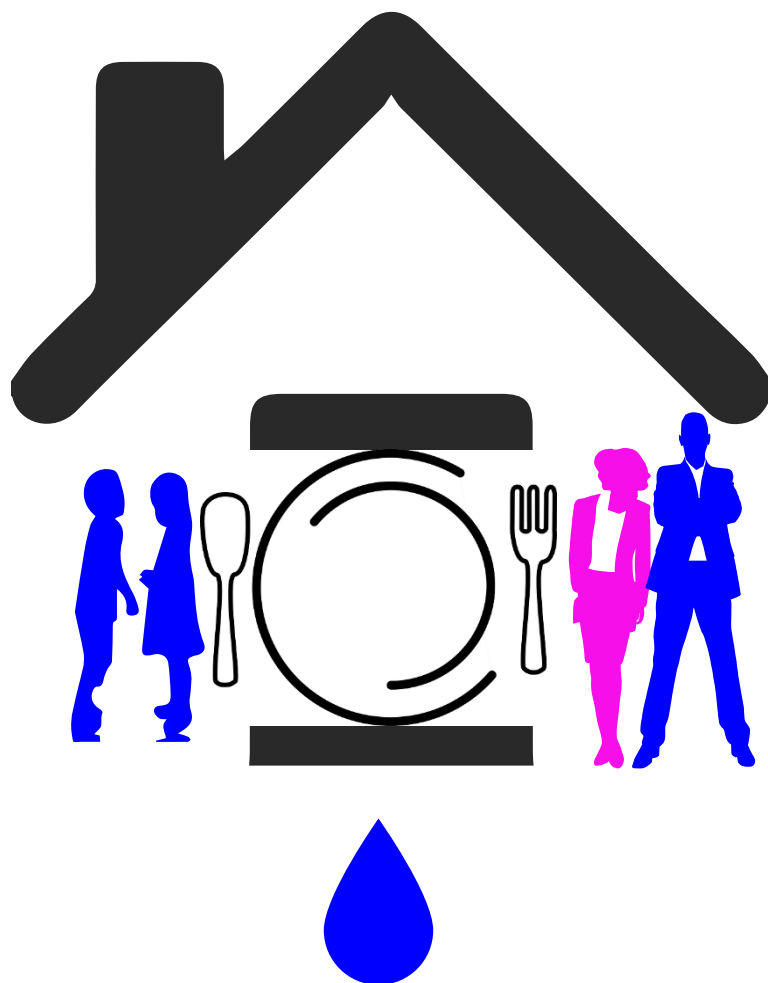

 - Life expectancy

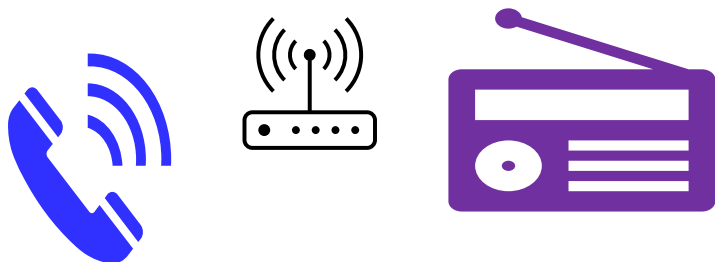

✓ Housing and household characteristics:

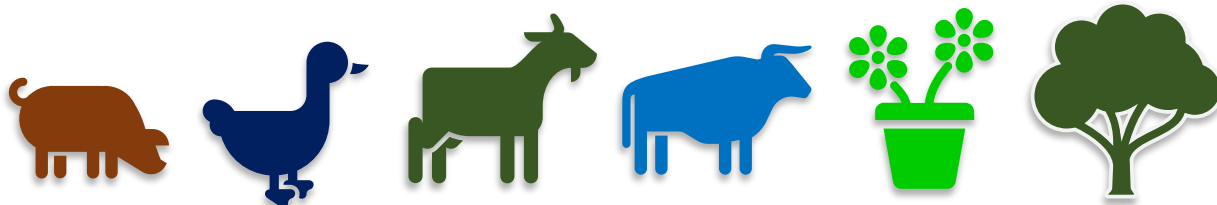
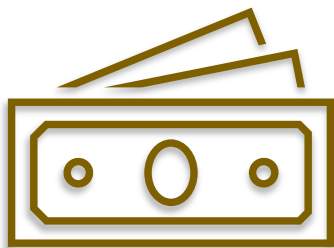
- Tenure, type, rooms and construction materials
- Food security
- Energy
- Water and Sanitation
- Household assets and ownership of basic items for each member (clothing and shoes)

- Main source of livelihood
- Remittances
- Agriculture
 - Mainly for sale or home consumption

✓ Community services

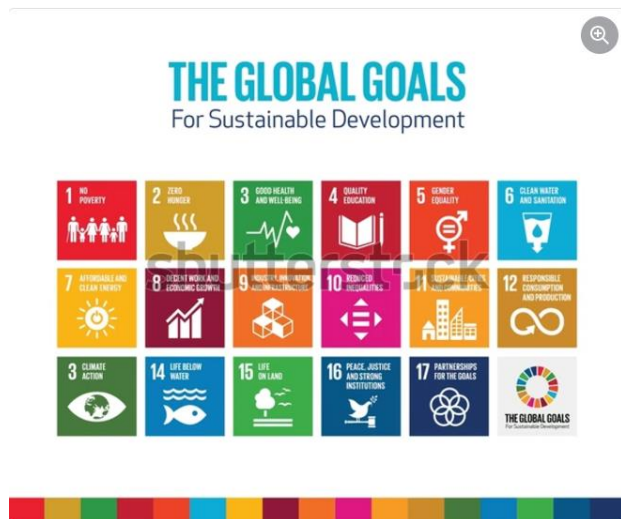
- Facilities (Education, health, etc)

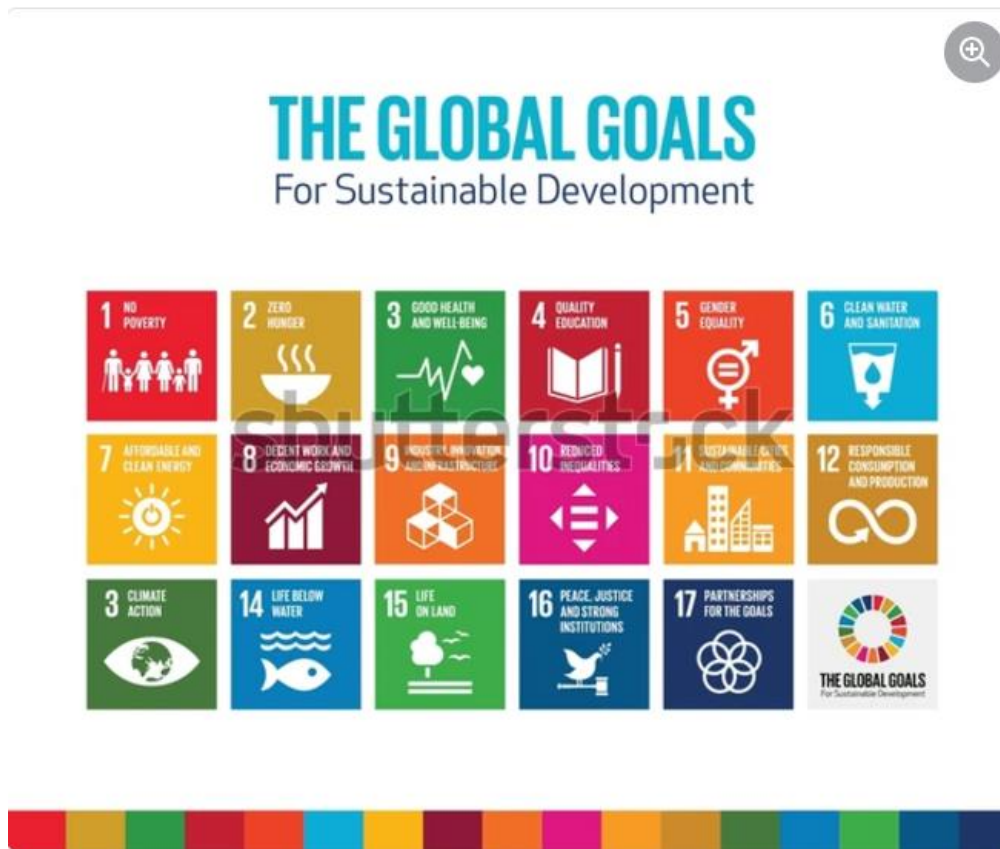
SDG Indicators produced

Five (5) indicators from the 54 Gender specific SDGs identified by UN Women:

- 1.4.2: Proportion of total adult population with secure tenure rights to land with legally recognized documentation
- 3.1.1: Maternal mortality ratio
- 3.7.2: Adolescent birth rates per 1,000 women
 - *Girls aged 10-14 years*
 - *Women aged 15-19 years*
- 5.b.1: Proportion of individuals (10 years and above) who own a mobile telephone
- 8.5.2 Unemployment rate
