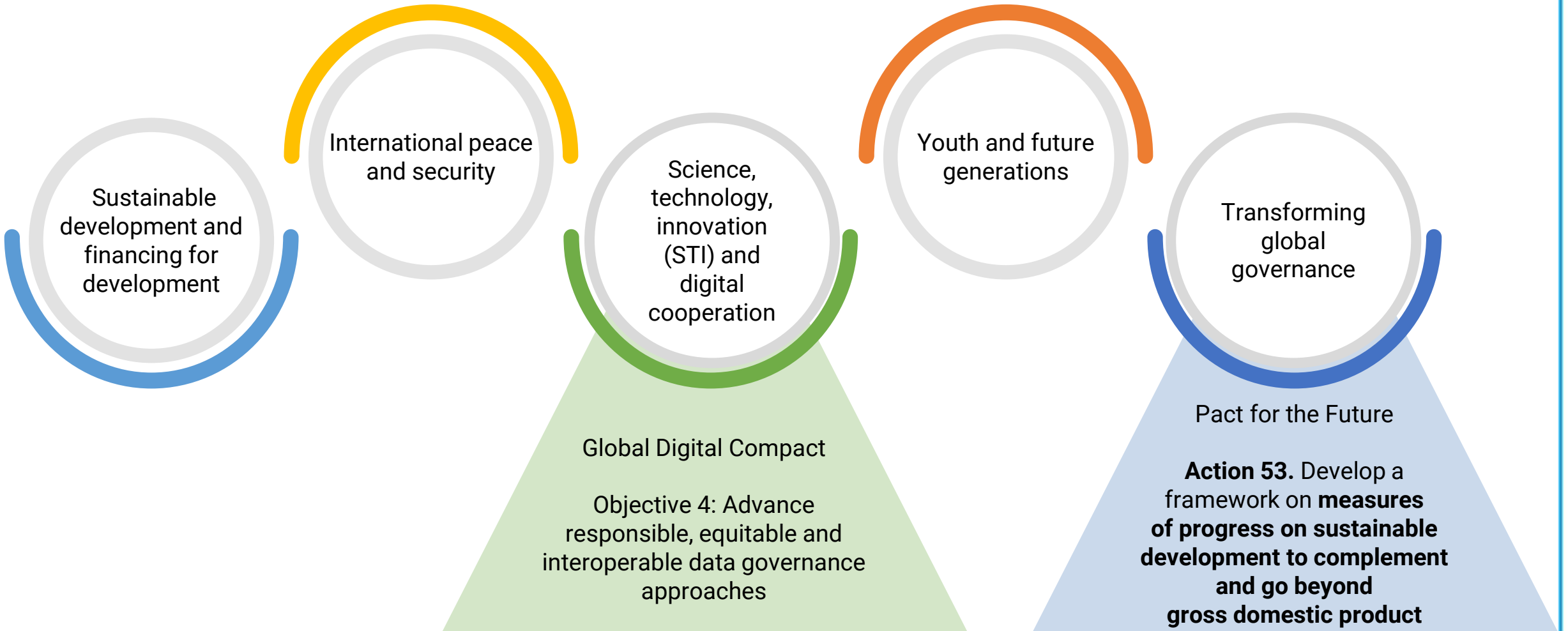

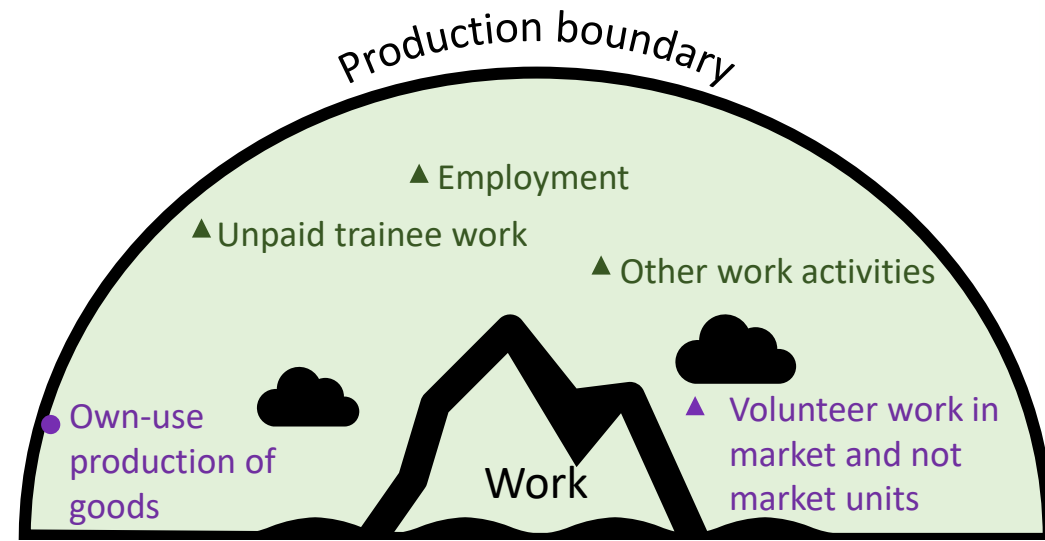

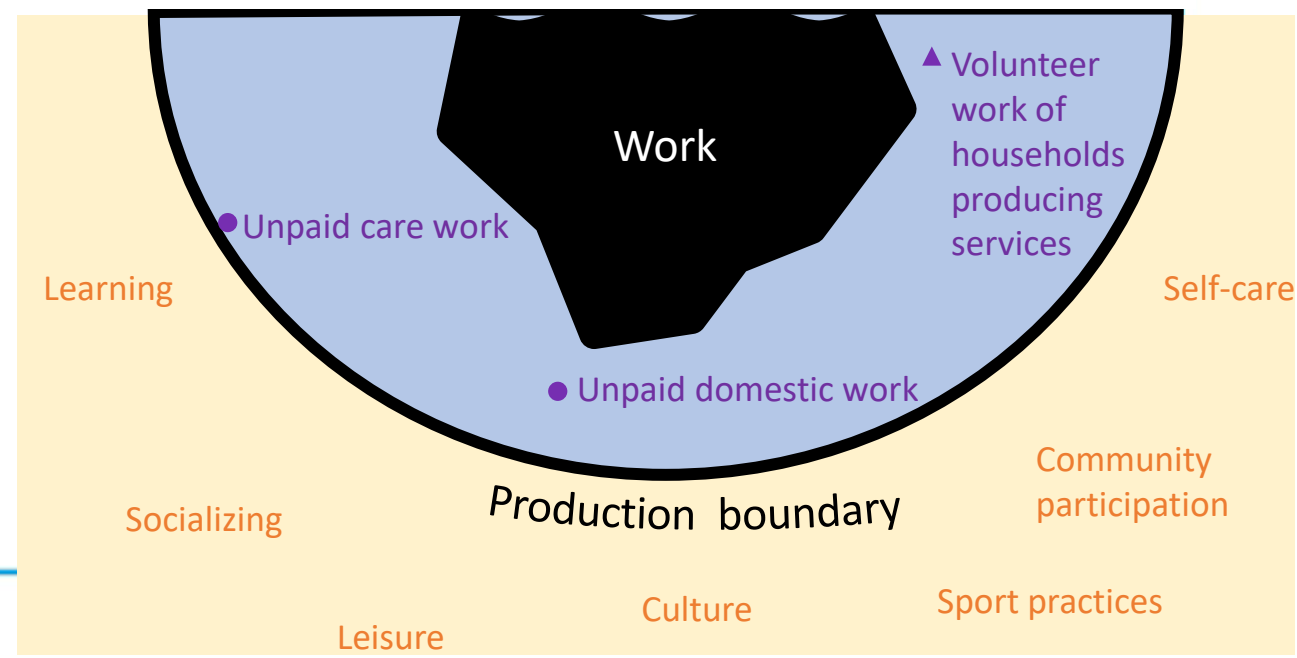

Production boundary of the System of National Accounts



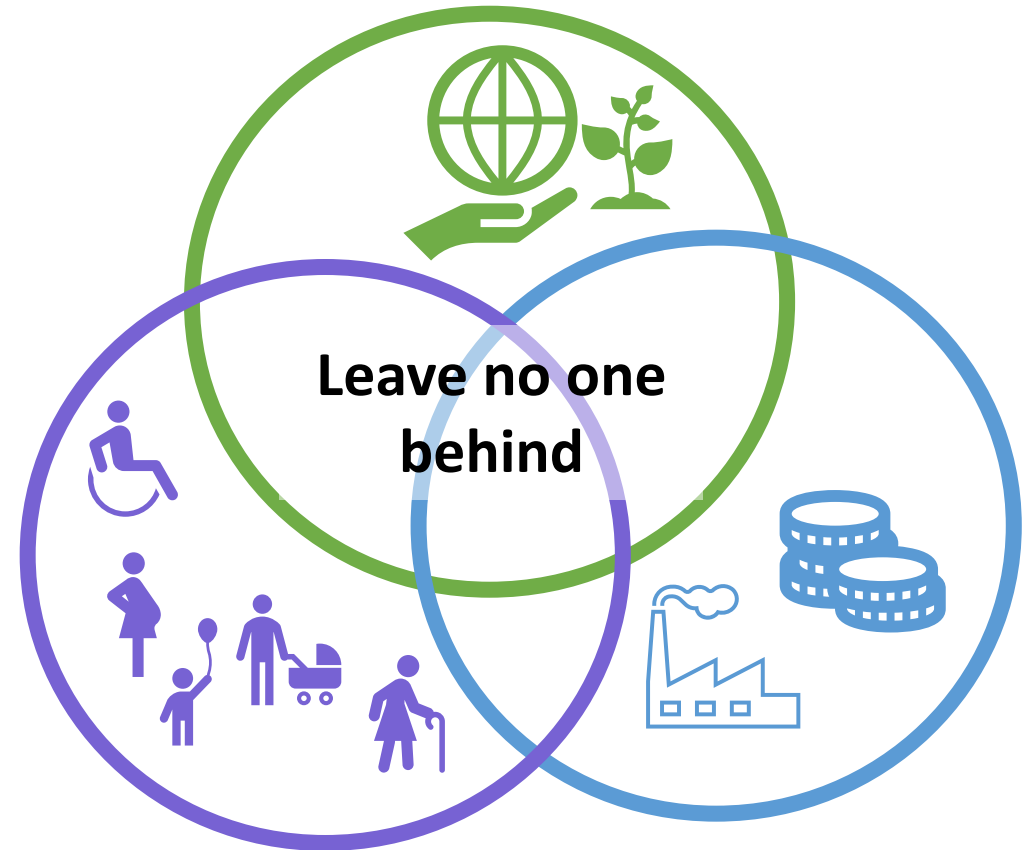

Gender lens

WHY?

Improve social and demographic statistics to better reflect society and its connections with the economy and environment.

Production: Agile and more responsive system of social and demographic statistics

Use: Inform policies of multi-dimensional trade-offs in the context of measuring inclusive and sustainable wellbeing and progress beyond GDP

Building blocks of an overarching conceptual framework for social and demographic statistics



PEOPLE

The fabric, object, and 'unit of measurement' for social and demographic statistics.

- ✓ Population stock
- ✓ Population flows
- ✓ Characteristics of individuals



RELATIONSHIPS

Interactions between individuals which collectively build up a society.

- ✓ Extent
- ✓ Function
- ✓ Quality
- ✓ Impact



OUTCOMES

Qualitative or compound measures to be assessed both objectively and subjectively.

- ✓ Objective: education, health, time use (such as unpaid work, work-life balance and leisure), employment, income, wealth and housing, among others
- ✓ Subjective: well-being, including physical and mental health, learning, sense of purpose, meaningful work, among others



PLACES

Geography as an element for analysing social and demographic statistics and as a link across themes and domains.

- ✓ Link different statistical domains
- ✓ Determinant of social outcomes
- ✓ Improve data quality



TIME

Time as an aid in understanding and anticipating changes in population, distribution outcomes and relationships.

- ✓ Calendar time
- ✓ Time-use
- ✓ Data production time
