

Main objective:
to improve the completeness and degree of harmonization of migration statistics

Harmonised and comparable
Community statistics on migration
and international protection are
essential for the development and
monitoring of Community legislation
and policies relating to immigration
and asylum, and to the free
movement of persons.



#### **European Statistical Office**



Eurostat is the statistical office of the European Union

Eurostat is responsible for the quality management of European statistics and establishes a system for the correct implementation of the European Statistics Code of Practice.

The European Statistical System (ESS) is a partnership between Eurostat and the national statistical offices (including Statistics Poland) and other national authorities responsible in each Member State for the creation, development and dissemination of European statistics

One of the nine thematic areas that EUROSTAT deals with is population and social conditions.

All changes resulting from the revised UN conceptual framework will be implemented first by EUROSTAT
