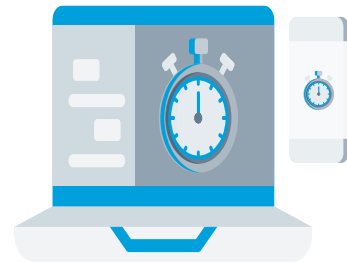

UN Guide: Continue to promote the recommendations for more frequent, more granular, and cost-effective time-use statistics	All
UN hub on time-use data resources: -continue to populate it with latest solutions/tools -and examples of data uses to promote time-use data for a wide variety of public policies and to assess well-being of the population and its sub-groups	<u>UNSD</u> , All
Organize and support capacity-building initiatives	All
Advocacy -engage diverse group of stakeholders in all high level meetings and events (WDF, Stats Commission, ...) -organize a series of webinars to promote the many uses of time-use data	All
Use of AI and machine learning techniques: explore, document and share the use of AI to improve time-use data production process, including for coding verbatim description of activities	<u>Italy</u> , <u>UNSD</u> , <u>Australia</u> , <u>Mexico</u> , <u>ILO</u>
