Plenary discussion

1. <u>Time-use data in the national data ecosystem</u>



- Does your NSO have a specific mandate to collect time-use data? Does it specify the periodicity of data collection?
- Are time-use data collections in your country part of a *specific programme* (allocated budget, dedicated team) or *integrated* into other statistical programs (including through modules or questions in other surveys).



2. Identifying users of Time-use statistics



- User groups : Who are current and/or potential users of time use statistics in your country?
- Users' needs: What information do they demand or could be useful for them?

3. Identifying uses of Time-use statistics

- *Time-use data and SDGs:* How does your country use time-use data to monitor SDGs?
- What are the *current trends* in time-use research/data collection?
- Which other topic areas might benefit from time-use data?



4. Challenges and lessons learned

- *Challenges of time-use statistics:* What are the challenges that your country experienced in the production of time-use statistics? How could the international community offer support?
- Lessons learned from the collection of time-use data: What mechanisms are in place for ensuring quality of time-use data collections? What partnerships are needed to strengthen time-use data?
