5,638 Crimes

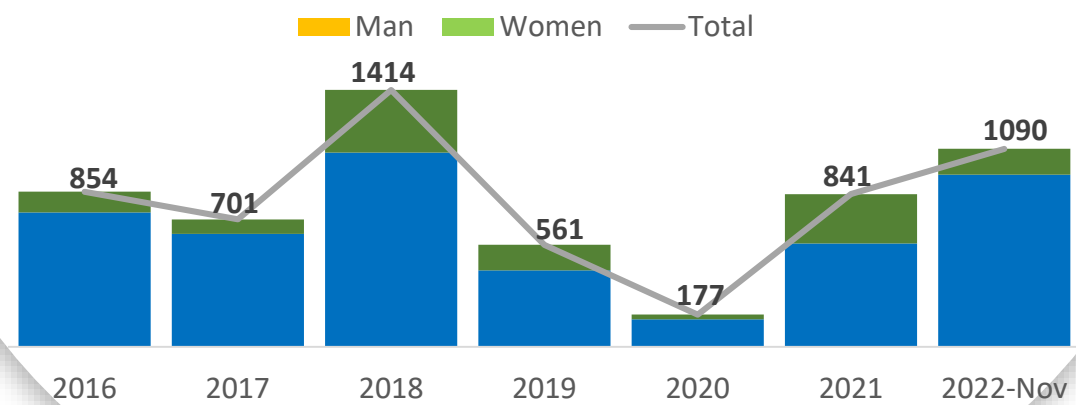
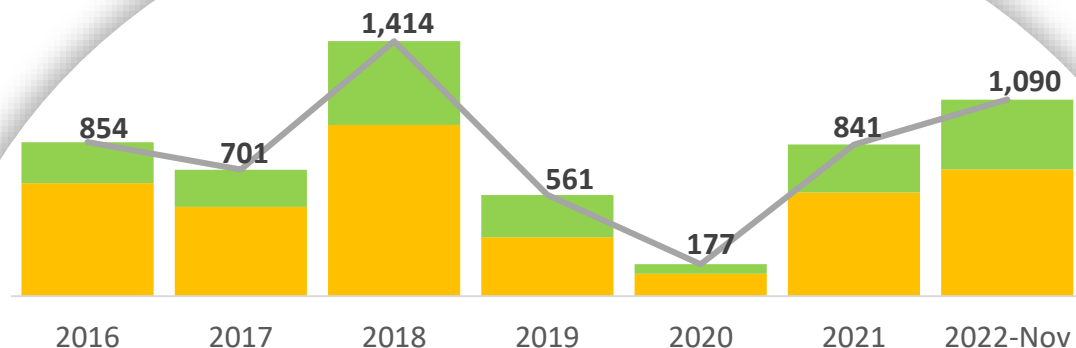
During the period From January 2016 until November 2022, 5,638 complaints of crimes against migrants were registered.

Year 2018

2018 was the year with more complaints registered with 1,414.

Year 2020

In 2020 there is a clear decrease, probably due to the reduction of migratory flows.



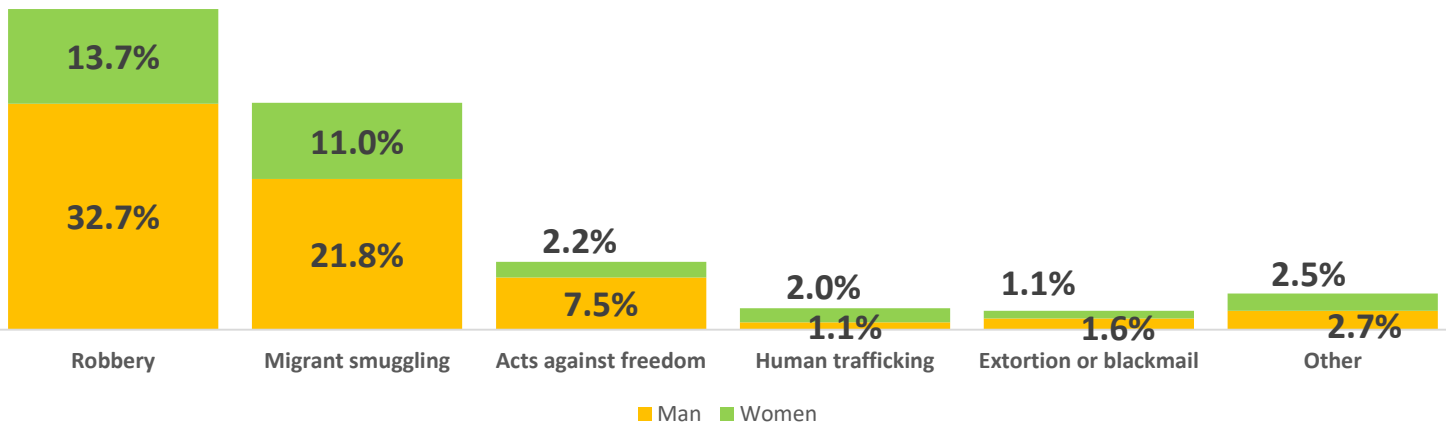
Sex

During the period, 68% of complaints were made by men.

Age

During the period, 20% of the reported crimes were against minors under 18 years of age.

Main crimes committed against persons in irregular migration 2016- Nov 2022



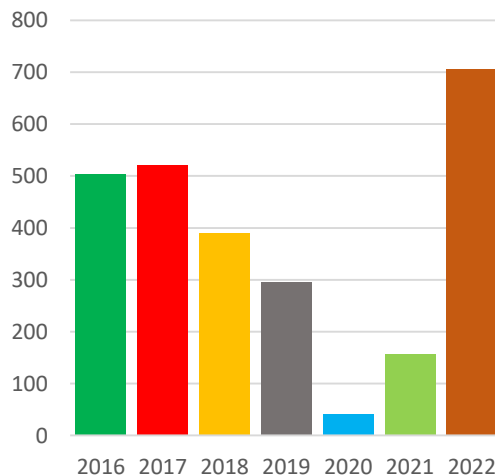
Focus

Robbery and human trafficking are the main crimes for both sex

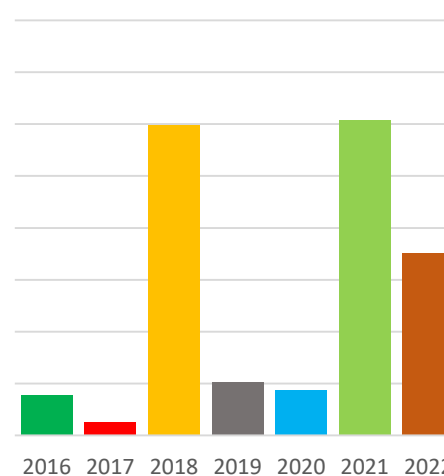
Focus

In 2016, 2017 and 2022, Robbery was the most highlighted crime and in 2018 and 2021 was the Migrant smuggling.

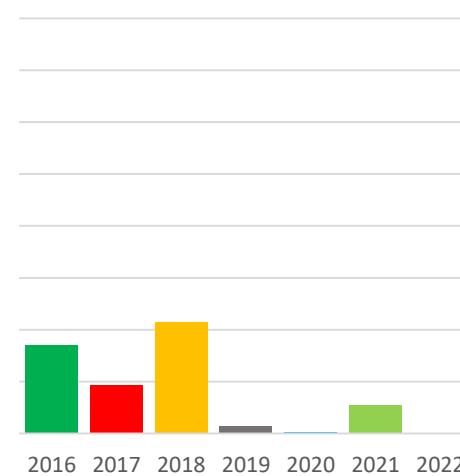

Nicaragua 15.0%

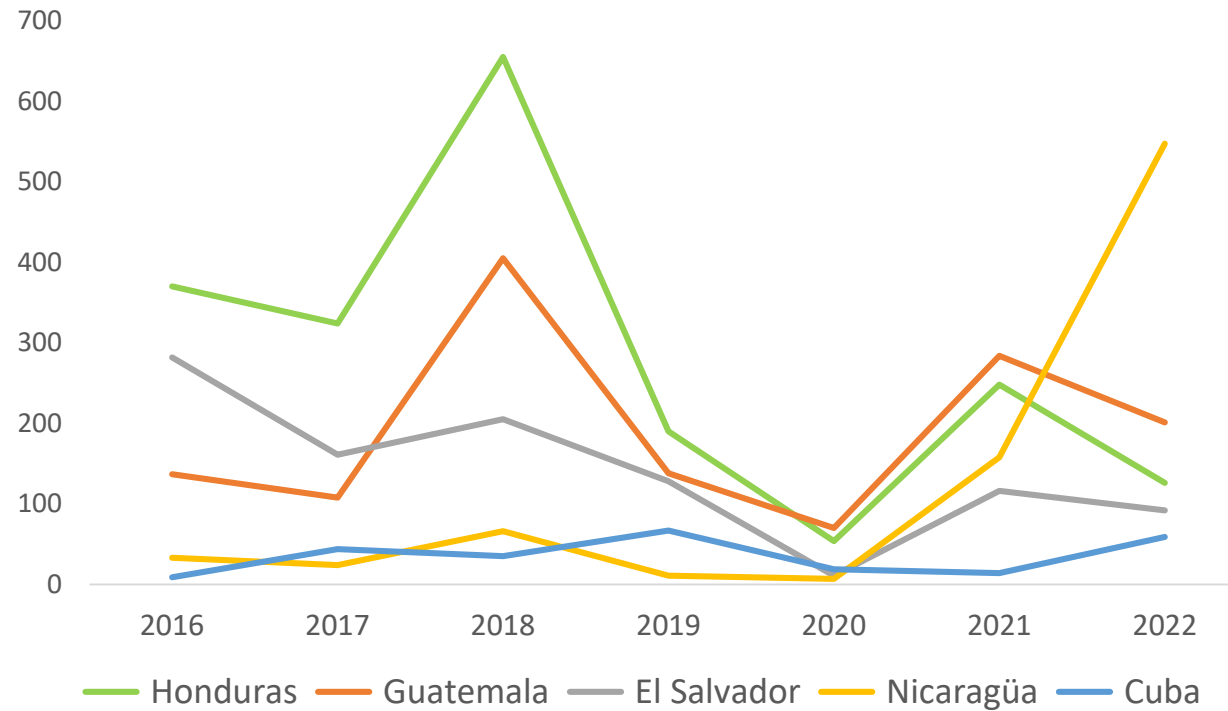


Cuba 4.4 %

The main countries of nationality are the same ones that predominate in irregular migratory flows through Mexico.

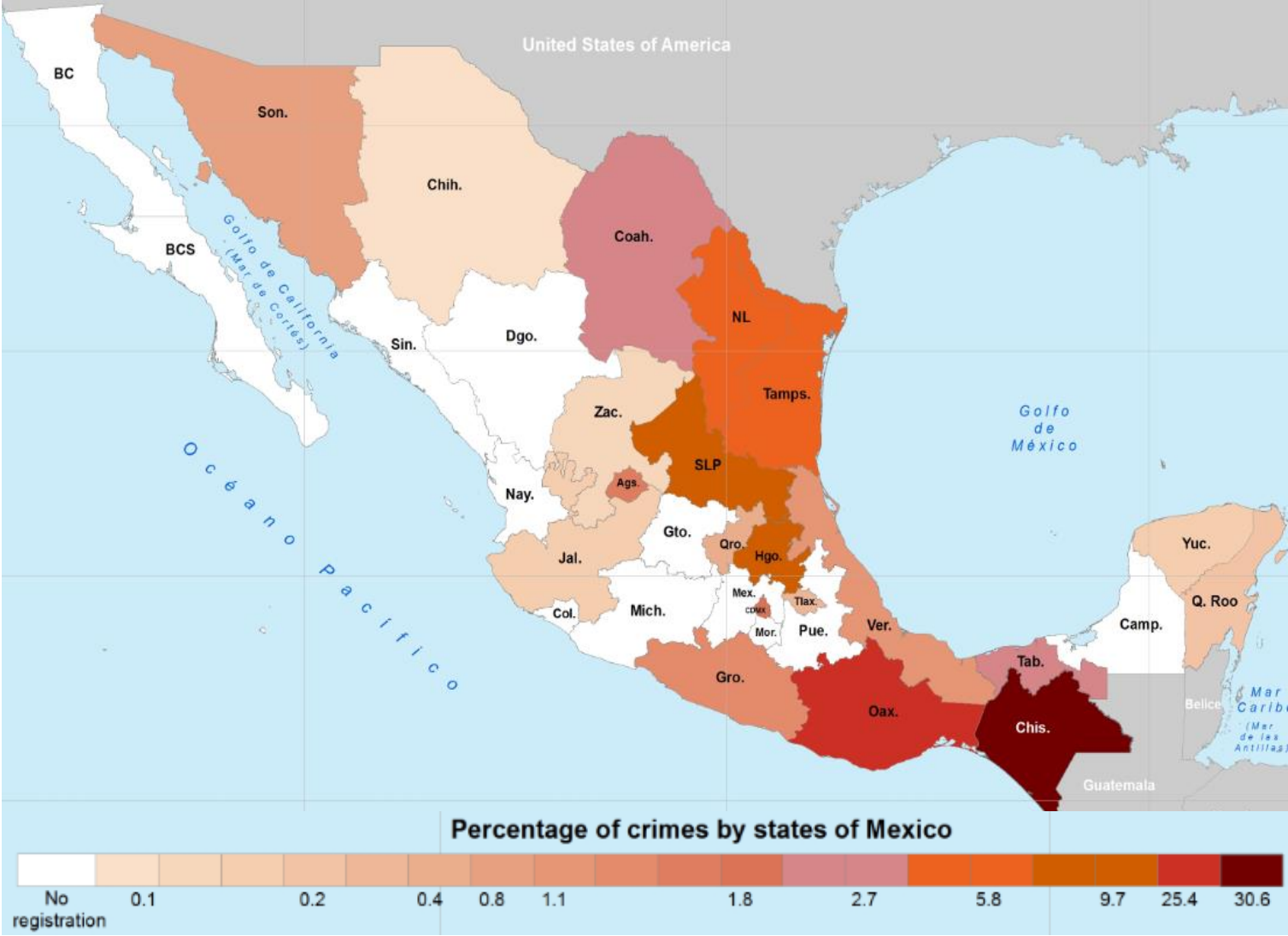
States in Mexico where the crime against persons in irregular migration was registered 2016- Nov 2022

Chiapas and Oaxaca are the main states where criminal complaints are made.

Between 24% and 38% of complaints were made by women in almost all the states.

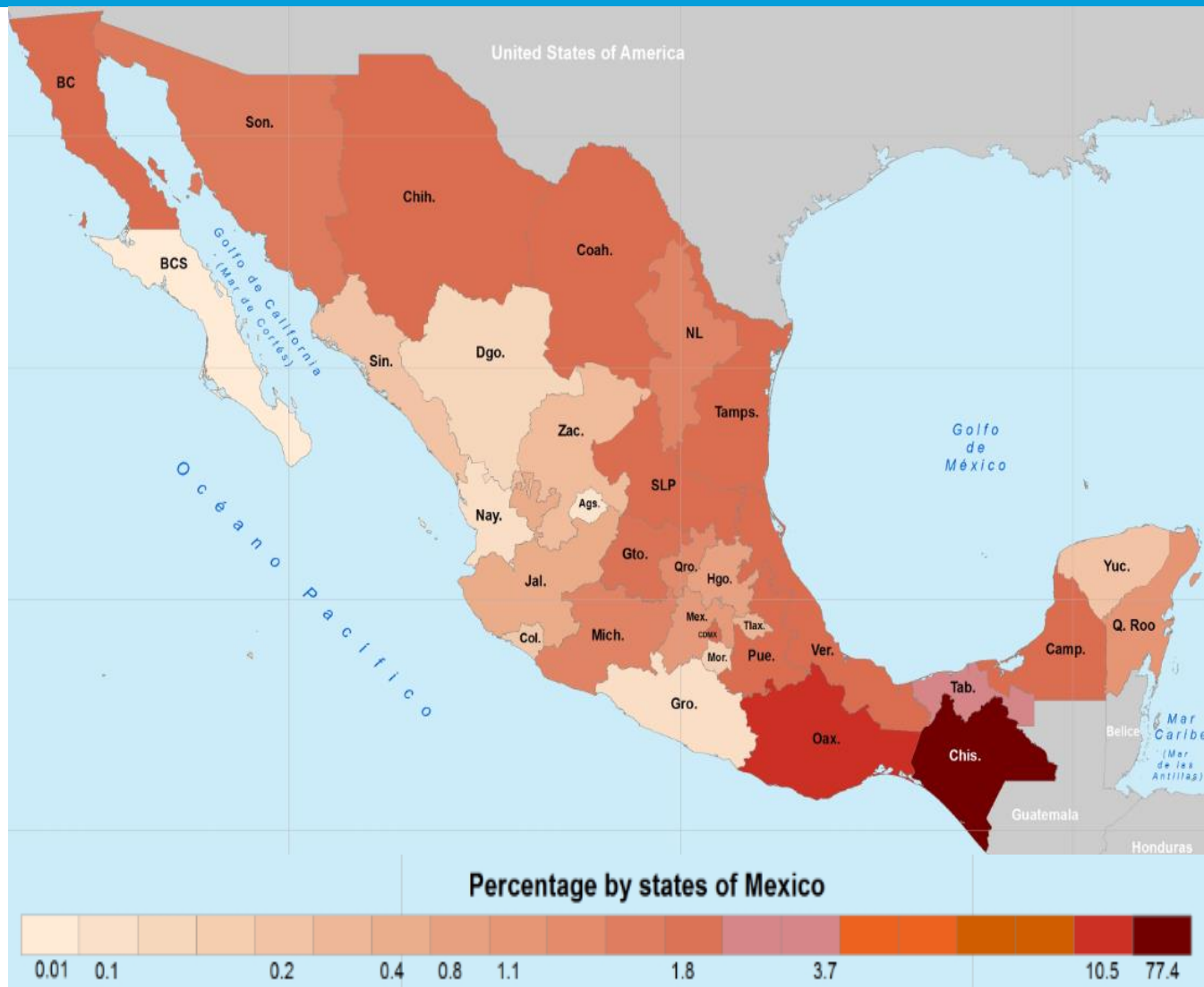
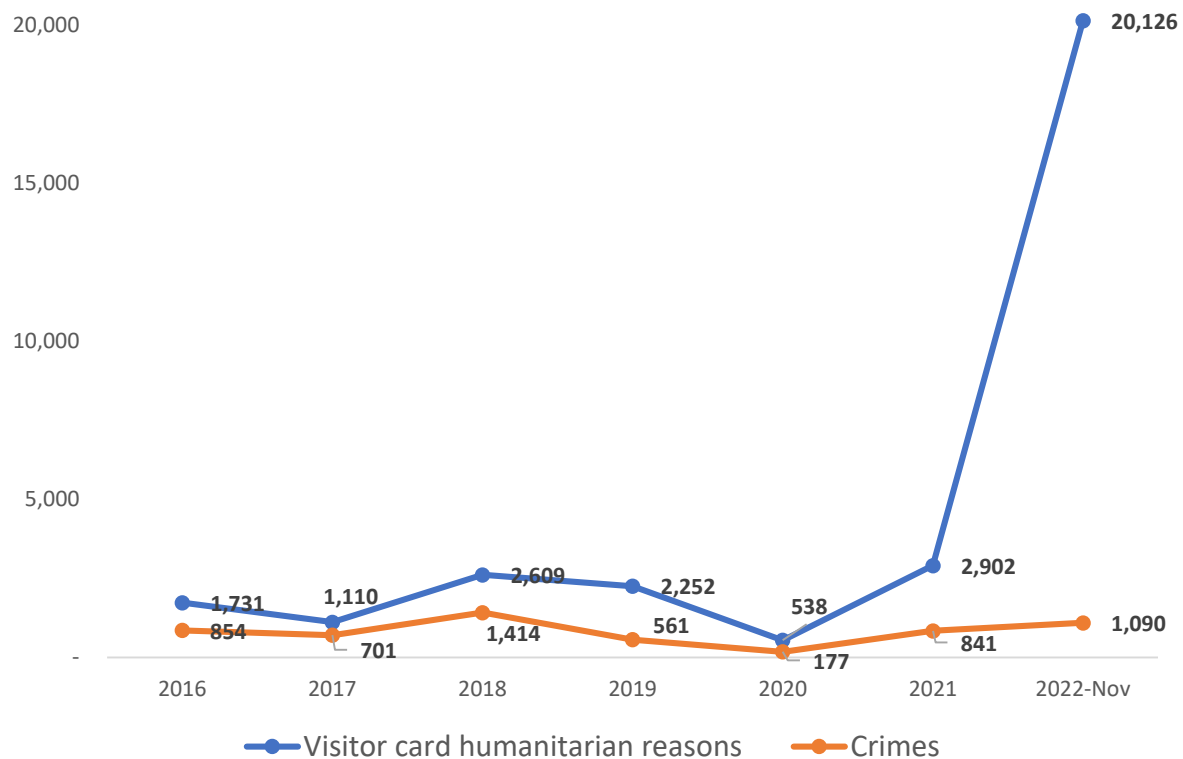
Coahuila and Querétaro have the lowest percentages of complaints made by women.

The statistics of the delivery of the TVRH to offended persons, victims or witnesses of a crime bring us closer to the number of migrants who were the object of a crime in the Mexican territory.
