Municipal Area : A municipal area is a legal unit established by the Royal Decree of the 1953 Municipal Act.

There are three categories of municipal areas : Nakhon (city), Muang (town) and Tambon (commune).

- A tambon municipality is established wherever it is deemed appropriate.

- A muang municipality is established *both cases* where the administrative seat of the provincial government is located or where the population is at least 10,000 persons, with an average density

of not less than 3,000 persons per square kilometer. The sources of tax revenue must also be sufficient for the execution of municipal affairs as stipulated in the 1953 Municipality Act.

- A Nakhon municipality is established in areas where the population, is at least 50,000 persons,

with an average density of not less than 3,000 persons per square kilometer. Tax revenues must also be sufficient for the execution of municipal affairs as stipulated in the 1953 Municipality Act.
