The division of population into rural and urban is based on the division of settlements into urban and rural. The transfer of a settlement from one into another category has been made by decrees of the Supreme Soviet of Estonia. The decisions are based on the regulation, adopted from 1.11.1974.

According to the regulation the settlement in most cases can be defined as urban if the size of the population exceeds 2000 and the percentage of economically active population engaged in non-agricultural sector exceeds 50%.
