Data dissemination 7th census, 2004

- **Census day of Seventh Population and Housing Census : August 1st, 2004.**
- **Aim of census project w.r.t. data dissemination:**
 - Completion of data processing a.s.a.p.
 - Dissemination of final results as close to census date as possible.
 - Census publication plan was announced beforehand.
- In practice: Project aimed at producing **all final results within 2 ¼ years** of enumeration.
- Selection of statistics for census publications: based on **national needs assessments** (e.g. stakeholders meetings) and **international recommendations**.

Dissemination of Seventh Census data

Through:

- Publications and CDs with (non-)printable pdf-files.
- Press conferences and other presentations
- Talk shows
- Promotion at the yearly trade and industry fair and other venues
- Selected census statistics on website of the General Bureau of Statistics

Seventh Census Publications

- Preliminary results: January 2005
(approx. 5 months after census taking)
- Four (4) final census publications on country level:
 - Volume 1 - Demographic and Social characteristics,
August 2005,
 - Volume 2 - Employment and Education statistics,
November 2005
 - Volume 3 - Fertility and Mortality , February 2006
 - Volume 4 - Households, Families and Dwellings, June 2006

Seventh Census Publications (continued)

Final results per district in five publications, for all 10 districts of Suriname:

- Paramaribo (June 2006)
- Para en Wanica (July 2006)
- Nickerie en Coronie (August 2006)
- Commewijne en Saramacca (September 2006)
- Marowijne, Brokopondo en Sipaliwini (October 2006)
- Census evaluation publication: last census-7 publication for the general public, released in December 2006.

8th Population and Housing Census (in August 2011):

Target: at least the same schedule of release of publications.

- Preliminary results: at most 4 months after census fieldwork
- Volume 1 - Demographic and Social characteristics, 12 months after census taking
- Volume 2 - Employment and education statistics, 15 months
- Volume 3 – Fertility and mortality , 18 months
- Volume 4 -Households, families and dwellings , 20 months

- All district publications, 24 months of census taking

8th Population and Housing Census data dissemination approach

Same data dissemination approach as with
Census-7:

- Hard and soft copy publications
- Press conferences for each census publication
- Talk shows and presentations w.r.t. census results
- Promotion of census data at the yearly trade and industry fair and other venues,
- Selected census statistics on website of the General Bureau of Statistics

8th Population and Housing Census (continued):

Also other ways of data dissemination:

- Production of **thematic maps** (in Censusinfo, CSPro and/or GIS software).
- **Poverty mapping** exercises
- **Interactive ways of data dissemination:**
 - Use and launch of Censusinfo, developed for 2010 Census Round.
Currently checking if the tables / maps can be produced with the current Suriname draft census questionnaire
 - Possibility: anonymized sample from the census data, which can be accessed (online in a microlab at the GBS) through a Redatam type data analysis software.
