Overview of Anguilla

Location	The island of Anguilla is about 16 miles long and 3.5 miles at its widest. The island is located at 18° 15' N, 63° 10' W.
Area	35 square miles (91km²) or approximately 22,400 sq acres
Number of smaller islands and cays (8)	The main island of Anguilla also has several off-shore cays and uninhabited islets, the largest of which are Prickly Pear East, Prickly Pear West, Dog Island, Scrub Island, Little Scrub Island, Sandy Island, Seal Island, Anguillita and Sombrero Island
Population	Anguilla had an estimated population of 13,548 persons (2011)

The Anguilla Statistics Department is tasked with the mandate, as set out in R.S.A 2001 Statistics Act, Section 2:

A

• to collect, compile, analyse, abstract and publish statistical information relative to the commercial, industrial, social, economic and general activities and conditions of the people who are the inhabitants of Anguilla;

• to collaborate with all other departments of Government and with local authorities in the collection, computation and publication of statistical records of administration;

C

• to take any census in Anguilla; and

D

• generally to organize a coordinated scheme of social and economic statistics and intelligence pertaining to Anguilla.

 To produce relevant and quality statistics for use by both the private and public sectors of Anguilla and other interested parties in their decision-making.

Our Vision

- To provide statistical services that maximize the appropriate use of statistics about Anguilla at home and overseas.

 Promote the effectiveness of the Anguilla Statistics Department by advising and working with the Department to produce relevant and accurate statistics about Anguilla's society and economy."

ANSAC tasked with:

- Assisting in fostering closer collaboration and coordination among data producers and users.
- Encouraging the use of international statistical standards, classification systems, procedures and methods.
- Building capacity, planning and prioritizing statistical activities within the NSS.
- Facilitating and assisting in statistical dissemination, promotion and advocacy.

Successes

Best Practice: Significant work underway with Education and Health.

- Frameworks for thematic statistics.
- Documentation of Statistics Metadata in each thematic area.
- Promoting an integrated approach for statistics was designed.

Establishing and Sustaining Trust

Theory:

- Involvement of wide cross section of populace building a rapport.
- Education and awareness of scientific and transparent methodologies used and the impartiality of their production.
- Emphasizing publicly and practicing the code of ethics and what is required by Statisticians (increasing the professionalism, impartiality and independence of Statisticians)
- Highlighting best practices
- Improving efficiencies

The Way Forward

- Continued collaboration with members of the ANSAC to expose them to the ASDs work programme and operating and technical standards in the science of statistics.
- Strengthening ties and mutual relations at national, regional and international levels.
- Harmonising and coordinating the collection and production of statistical data and data series.
- Supporting efforts to ensure compliance (improving the execution of the laws).
- Continued promotion of the use of data and scientific methods in policy and programme design as well as decision making.
- Continued planning and promotion of annual awareness programmes to broaden the understanding and usefulness of statistics in the community.
