## Practice of dissemination of energy statistics data in the State Statistical Committee of the Republic of Azerbaijan

Dissemination of statistical data by the State Statistical Committee (SSC) of the Republic of Azerbaijan is carried out in accordance with the dissemination policy.

The section "Statistical Publications" of the webpage of the SSC includes information on release date of all statistical publications, including release date of publication on energy statistics. The statistical bulletin "About the movement of energy resources" and statistical yearbooks "Statistical indicators of Azerbaijan" and "Energy industry of Azerbaijan" developed in the Excel, PDF, HTML formats are posted on the corresponding links of the State Statistical Committee of the Republic of Azerbaijan:

The information in e-formats on oil and oil products, gas, heating and electricity, renewable energy sources thereafter find reflection in the international publications of BP, JODİ, UN, ADB, ECO, Eurostat, INOGATE, IEA as well as other international organizations and publications of the Committee.

According to policy on dissemination of official statistical data, all users can obtain statistical information free of charge. Users are able to study publications related all branches of statistics as well as issued collections in an electronic format.

During implementation of a number of actions the system of standards of statistical data and metadata exchange (SDMX) has been started since May, 2013 where data on energy are also reflected. The SDMX defines formats for an exchange of aggregated statistical data and metadata necessary for understanding how these data are structured.

It is necessary to note that distribution of data on energy via Internet allowed energy sector to create more direct relations with users.

With the aim to ensure effective transfer of national data to wide range of users the exchange of statistical data is supported continually.
