Overview

- Previous global assessment conducted in 2006
- Evaluated status of environmental statistics and environmental-economic accounts (Phase I)
- Follow-up surveys on water and energy sent to countries indicating activities in those areas (Phase II)
- 100 countries responded to Phase I
 - 49 countries had accounting programme





Rationale for 2013 Global Assessment

- 2006 survey indicated countries had plans to implement environmental-economic accounts
- New survey would indicate progress in accounts since 2006
- Provides a baseline as work on the SEEA implementation strategy begins







Proposed Survey Structure

- Administer to all UN Member States
- Focus on environmental-economic accounting status
- Short survey to encourage response
- Proposed questions include:
 - Established environmental-economic accounting programme?
 - Key elements of accounting programme and agencies involved?
 - Technical assistance received?

Proposed Timeline



August 2013	Approval by UNCEEA Bureau of final set of questions and contacts
August 2013 – December 2013	Survey administration
October 2013 – February 2014	Compilation of survey results
Early March 2014	Survey results reported
