Project was called for by the environmental ministers in the Nordic countries

- Ministers asked for help from Nordic statistical offices and environmental ministries (Denmark, Finland, Norway, Sweden) to increase use of Sustainable Development Indicators
- Nordic SDI:s are available, but there is a notion that they are under-used
- The project has a goal to suggest how the information can be presented to increase use



Nordic environmental account, regular reporting of

- Emissions to air by industry
- Environmental economic instruments: taxes and subsidies
- Material flows, Energy use by industry
- Depending on funding, possibly additional modules.
