




Data and information have different target audiences. Different levels of aggregation are necessary.




Water efficiency and decoupling is multidimensional. Three aspects impacting water use are shown below:




Use of maps to show contrasts in regions.

Water balance in a user friendly format




The production of information is a continuous improvement process.


