- □ Environment Statistics
  - ➤ In 1999, initiated Philippine Framework on the Development of Environment Statistics (PFDES) based on the United Nations FDES
     ✓ With ADB funding
  - ➤ Published <u>Compendium of Philippine</u> <u>Environment Statistics</u> (CPES) 2000, since then it is published every other year

### > Introduction

- □ Environment Statistics
- ➤ In 2007, established the Inter Agency Committee on Environment & Natural Resources Statistics (IACENRS).
  - -Chaired by the Undersecretary of DENR for Policy and Planning
  - -Among the major functions of IACENRs
    - ✓ Serve as a forum for discussion and resolution of concerns/problems and issues in the compilation of ENR statistics and accounts;
    - ✓ Recommend policies and standards for the improvement of data generation & dissemination system of ENR statistics and accounts

IACENRS established the following Technical Working groups (TWG):

- ✓ TWG Water Resource Statistics (2009)
- ✓ TWG Land & Soil Resource Statistics (2009)
- √ TWG Mineral Resource Statistics (2013)

## > Introduction

### □ Environment Statistics

- ➤ In 2009, (former NSCB) drafted a framework for indicators on climate change using the old FDES
- ➤ In Oct 2013, conducted the training-workshop of the revised FDES (ESSAT was also used)
- ➤ Currently, the data assessment is being detailed and institutional arrangements is being drafted (an input to the IACENRS work program).
  - -A portal for environment statistics is being developed through the IACENRS.

## ■ Major Comments:

- Participants in the Oct 2013 FDES, found it helpful in their line of work
- Comprehensive and systematic for a pilot assessment of environment statistics.
- ESSAT should be done in collaboration with other concerned agencies.
- Able to visualized other uses of FDES (eg. climate change indicators, water statistics etc.)
- FDES as framework for coordination on environment statistics & for budgetary purposes.
