### 2. Introduction

- Novel type of statistics: on environmental education, awareness & engagement, yet with early example – Belize Census question in 2000
- 2. Linked to new discourses, such as ecosystem services, and new initiatives, such as Ocean Literacy
- 3. All Multilateral Environment Agreements emphasize the role of awareness raising
- 4. Principle 10 of the 1992 Rio Declaration sets out three fundamental rights as the key pillars of sound environmental governance.
  - They are access to information, access to public participation and access to justice
- 5. Environmental engagement and participation is desirable in all environmental management and development programmes and projects.
- 6. This methodology sheet cover formal and informal ways
- 7. Traditional/indigenous sources should not be left out
  - Example Hualapai people



- Mostly descriptive information, few definitions applicable in statistics
- NGO "A non-governmental organisation is a permanent organisation of individuals or groups of individuals qualified in relevant fields and operating independently from government influence"
- Public participation is 'any process that directly engages the public in decisionmaking and gives full consideration to public input in making that decision' (US-EPA)
- Environmental perception is "an intuitive recognition or understanding of the ecosystem and its natural resources, often based on human experiences or cultural attitudes or beliefs." (GEMET: 2017 online).
- Knowledge refers to a community's understanding of a given topic and attitudes refers to their feelings towards the topic. (K. Kaliyaperumal).

#### Environmental information systems (FDES 6.4.1.a)

A Shared Environmental Information System (SEIS) is a concept underpinned by a series of principles designed to ensure that environmental information is organized as effectively as possible and investments allocated towards monitoring and information gathering processes lead to the greatest possible benefits in terms of the use that is made of the resulting data

#### **Environmental education (FDES 6.4.2.a)**

Environmental education is the process of recognizing values and clarifying concepts in order to develop skills and attitudes necessary to understand and appreciate the inter-relatedness among humans, culture and their biophysical surroundings. It also entails practice in decision-making and self-formulation of a code of behaviour about issues concerning environmental quality (IUCN 1971)

Special Eurobarometer survey: Attitudes of Europeans towards Biodiversity, December 2018

This survey was designed to explore European citizens' awareness of and views on biodiversity and nature. It follows a previous survey on the same issues which was conducted in May-June 2015. This survey was designed to explore:

- Awareness of the term "biodiversity";
- Perceptions of the biggest threats to biodiversity;
- Perceptions of the reasons for stopping the loss of biodiversity;
- What the EU should do to prevent the loss of biodiversity;
- Awareness about the Natura 2000 network, the perceived importance of nature protection areas, and attitudes to developments that may damage these areas.





#### Attitudes of Europeans towards Biodiversity

This survey was designed to explore European citizens' awareness of and views on biodiversity and nature. Earlier surveys on the same topic were made in 2007, 2010, 2013 and 2015. The current survey (carried out in December 2018) addresses a sub-set of the questions asked in the previous ones and explores more particularly citizens views and opinions on the following topics: - Awareness of the term "biodiversity" - Perceptions of the biggest threats to biodiversity -Reasons for stopping the loss of biodiversity - What the EU should do to prevent the loss of biodiversity - Awareness about the Natura 2000 network, of the importance of nature protection areas and of attitudes to developments that may damage these areas



#### How do we build a stronger, more united Europe? The views of young people

Through this survey more than 10.000 young people across the EU (between 15 and 30 years) expressed their views on what the EU priorities should be as well as where education and training should focus in the years to come. Additionally, the survey provides an overview on young people's trends regarding their social and civic participation. Finally, it illustrates the situation regarding youth mobility and helps to identify the main reasons that possibly impede young people from taking part in a learning experience abroad.




Europeans' attitudes towards vaccination

### SDGs

There are no global statistics for environmental perception and awareness, but the SDG 4 states "ensure inclusive and equitable quality education and promote lifelong learning opportunities for all" and its target 4.7 reads that by 2030, ensure that all learners acquire the knowledge and skills needed to promote sustainable development, including, among others, through education for sustainable development and sustainable lifestyles amongst others. The indicator for this target, 4.7.1 reads, the percentage of 15-year old students enrolled in secondary school demonstrating at least a fixed level of knowledge across a selection of topics in environmental science and geoscience.

Goal 13 aims to take urgent action to combat climate change and its impacts through its target 13.3, to improve education, awareness-raising and human and institutional capacity on climate change mitigation, adaptation, impact reduction and early warning. The indicator 13.3.1 states the number of countries that have integrated mitigation, adaptation, impact reduction and early warning into primary, secondary and tertiary curricula.
