

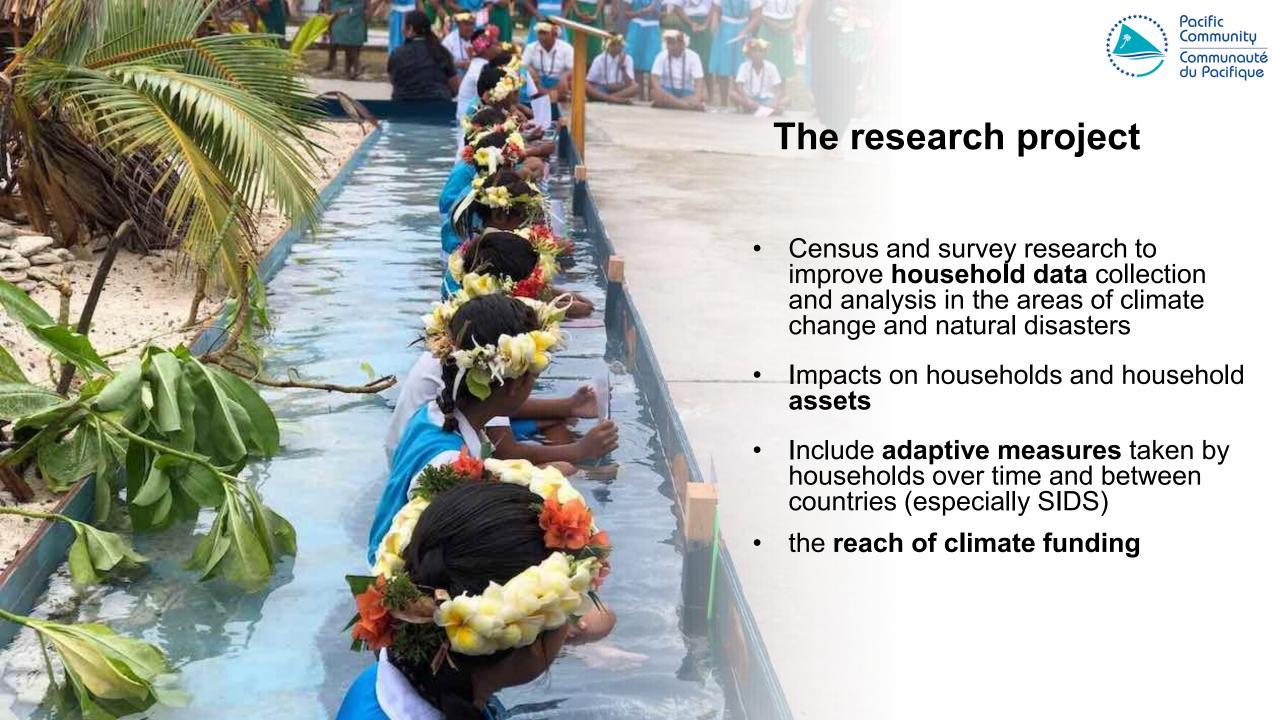

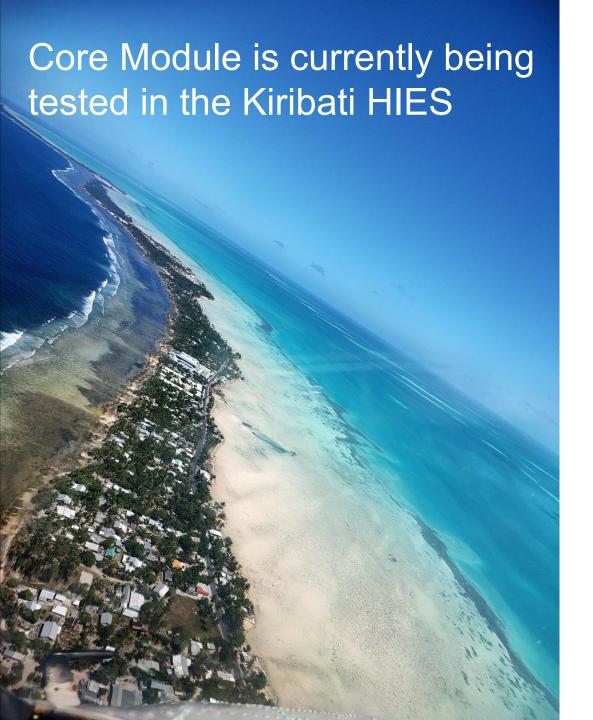

#### What will we be able to report?



- Estimated economic value of the damage inflicted
  - on dwelling and household assets;
  - to agriculture and forest areas, farm animals, farm assets, fisheries assets, etc.;
- Number of persons, missing, injured, ill, or dead;
- Impact on the access to
  - local transportation;
  - Work, education and health facilities: number of people affected and number of days lost or no access;
- Disruptions to basic services (electricity, water/sanitation, internet, etc.) + time involved;
- **Displacement of household members**: number of people forced to leave their locality (evacuated or displaced) either temporarily or permanently and destination (within or outside the country).
- Other consequences affecting households after a natural disaster e.g. loss in non-farm income, increased time spent on collecting water or firewood etc
