# What will we be able to report?

- **Estimated economic value** of the damage inflicted
  - on dwelling and household assets;
  - to agriculture and forest areas, farm animals, farm assets, fisheries assets, etc.;
- Number of **persons, missing, injured, ill, or dead**;
- **Impact on the access to**
  - local transportation;
  - Work, education and health facilities: number of people affected and number of days lost or no access;
- **Disruptions to basic services** (electricity, water/sanitation, internet, etc.) + time involved;
- **Displacement of household members**: number of people forced to leave their locality (evacuated or displaced) – either temporarily or permanently – and destination (within or outside the country).
- **Other consequences affecting households after a natural disaster** e.g. loss in non-farm income, increased time spent on collecting water or firewood etc
