


Availability of Information for Data Assessment Gap








Proportion of Available Statistics Belize

Methodological/Technical difficulty in data collection

Insufficient quality

Inaccessibility

Lack of institutional set-up/coordination

Insufficient or non-existent metadata


Accuracy
