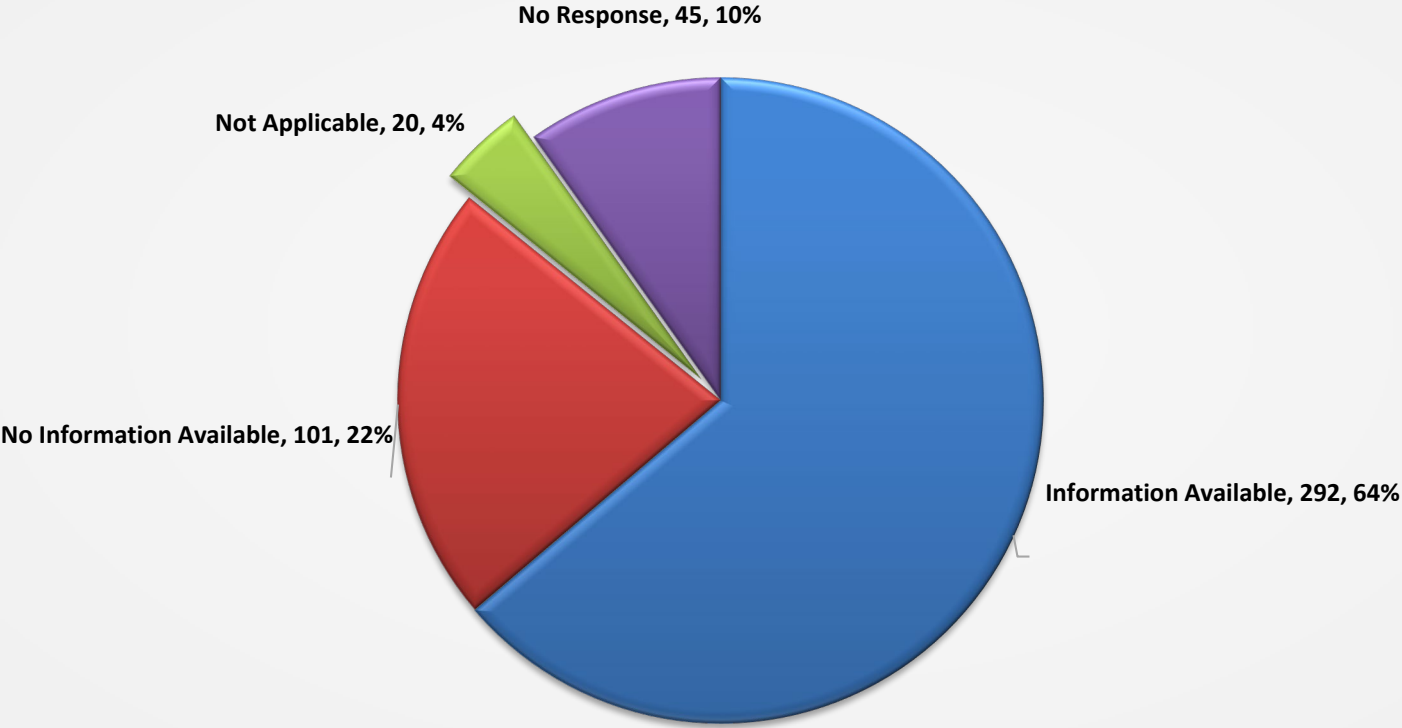

## Availability of Information for Data Assessment Gap

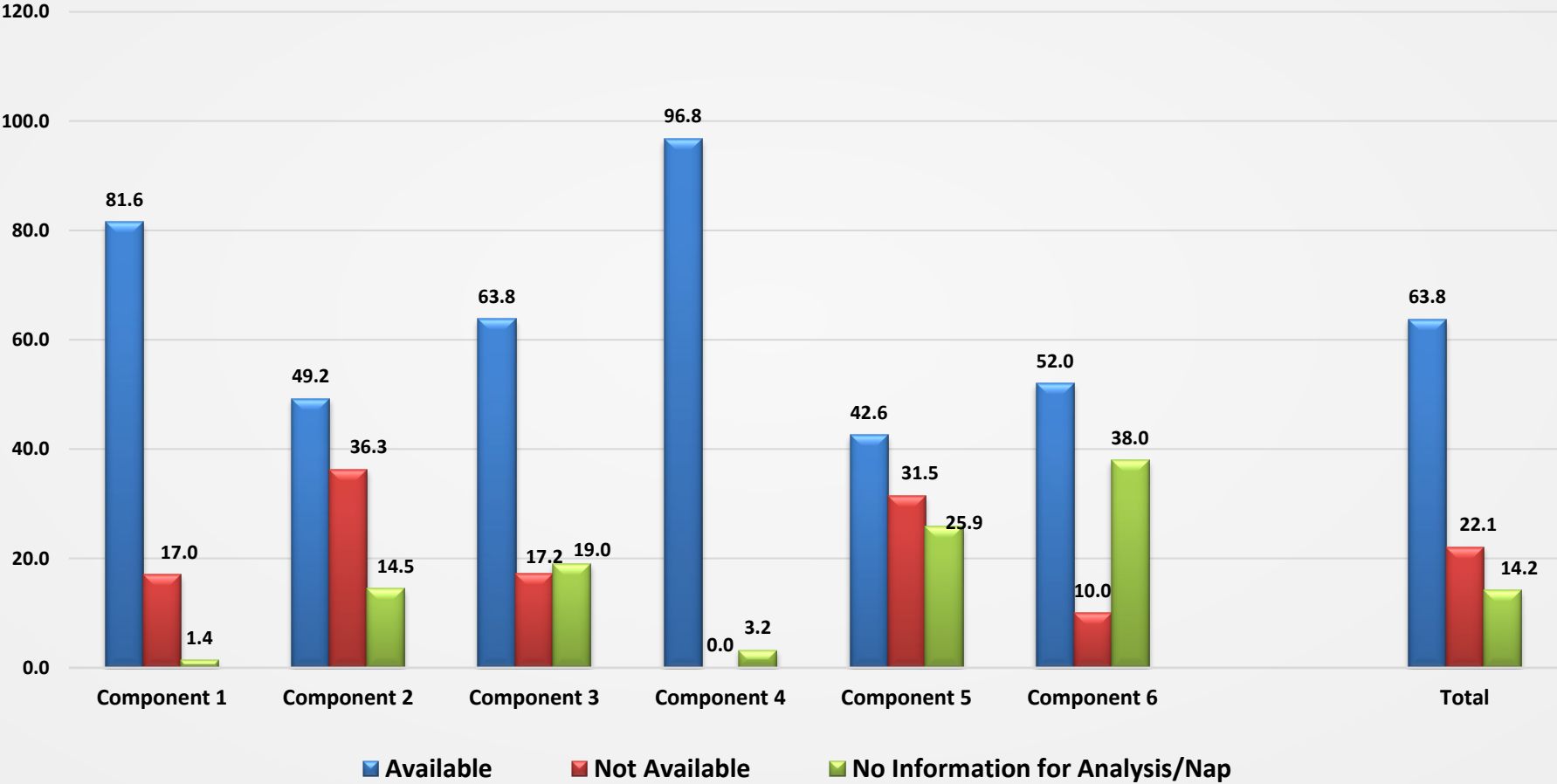


■ Information Available ■ No Information Available ■ Not Applicable ■ No Response

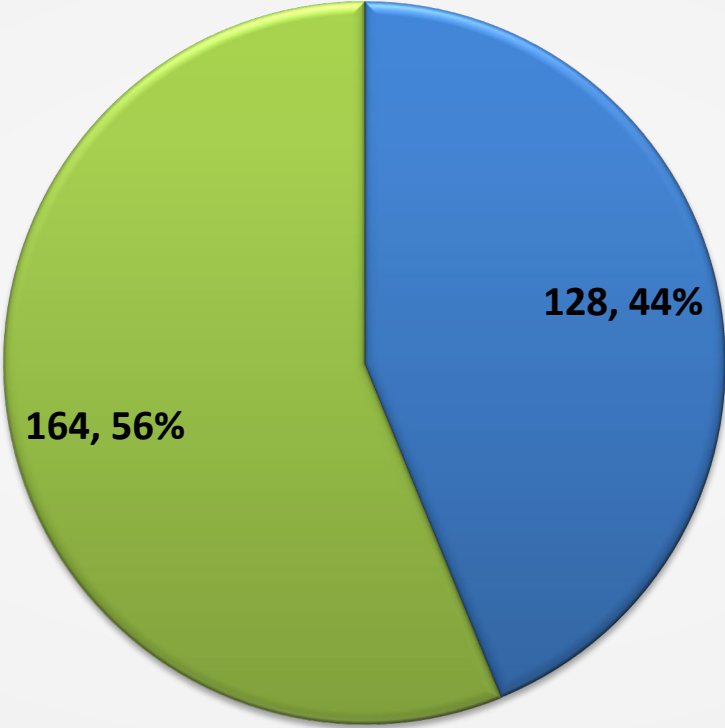
### Proportion of Available Statistics Belize

**R**esource constraints

**M**ethodological/Technical difficulty in data collection

**I**nsufficient quality

**I**naccessibility

**L**ack of institutional set-up/coordination

**O**ther difficulties in data collection

*Insufficient or non-existent metadata*

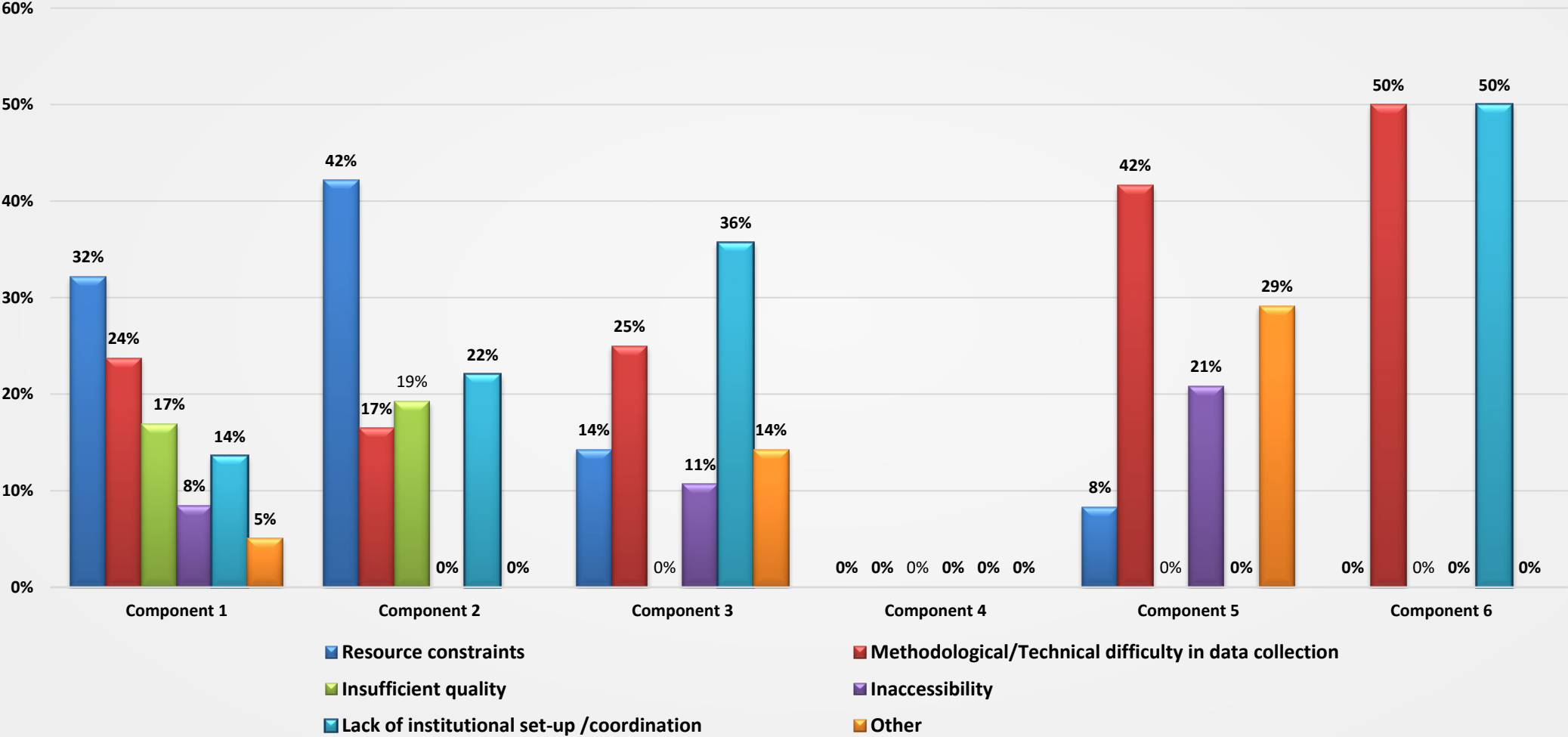
*Accuracy*
