CAPACITY BUILDING ACTIVITIES IN ENVIRONMENT AND CLIMATE CHANGE STATISTICS

- Support for the review of the draft Global Set of Climate Change Statistics and Indicators and its adoption.




RECOMMENDATIONS

- National Statistics Offices (NSOs) will need more capacity-building and investment and related support from their respective Governments as well as from International Development Partners;
- NSOs also need to work closely with environmental agencies that produce data for administrative purposes;
- There is need to perhaps have dedicated personnel wherever feasible in NSOs to enable concerted attention to this area of statistics.
- Regular meetings of the TWG for Environment and Climate Change Statistics

- Publication of the fifth CARICOM Environment in figures report Q3-2023
- 11th EDF Project planned activities:
 - Five (5) in-country technical assistance missions
 - Face-to-face meeting of the TWG Q1-2023
 - Regional Environment Workshop Q4-2023
- Related 11th EDF projects:
 - Establishment of a central Repository at RSP
 - Development of an electronic Caribbean Institute for Statistical Training and Research (e-CISTAR)
- Support countries to implement the Global Set and the climate-ESSAT
