Process



- Workshops are organised at national levels where all the relevant stakeholders are invited
- A Consultant and other staff of COMESA Secretariat facilitate the initial national workshop and its follow ups
- The stakeholders are identified according to the topics in the 6 components of the FDES 2013
- Capacity is built for stakeholders during the initial national workshop

Process



- At the same time, the stakeholders participate in group discussions to assess the ES using the ESSAT
- In this way, the data availability and sources are made to be known to the focal institutions driving the implementation process
- Core data set from the basic set in the FDES is focused initially
- Stakeholders agree on road map



Process



- The stakeholders are then required to provide available data in the short term
- A validation workshop follows
- A publishable draft report is prepared and validated in another workshop
- The COMESA Consultant facilitates the process to guide the data collection, until its final publication





- Assessment was made to gather information on the status of Environment Statistics (ES)
 - Rather poor ES were available in many countries
- Road Map was adopted by COMESA for implementation of FDES 2013





- Regional Workshop held in Mauritius, organised jointly by UNSD and COMESA
- National Workshop held in Zambia to kick start the FDES implementation process
- Zimbabwe as well carried out its national workshop
- Follow up national workshops were held for data and report validations



- Ethiopia kick started its FDES 2013 implementation with a national workshop
- Madagascar, initiated its FDES implementation and published its ES report
- Zimbabwe published its Environment Statistics Bulletin
- Zambia prepared draft Environment Statistics Bulletin
- Egypt held its national workshop for FDES 2013 implementation







- Seychelles kick started its FDES implementation with a national workshop in February Stakeholders provided valuable information about data availability
- Available data collection was initiated
- Ethiopia prepared its ES Bulletin and is about to publish
- COMESA support for FDES implementation is still underway
- New areas are identified, as per requirements of the COMESA Committee on Statistical Matters
 e.g. Blue Economy....
