Use EU limit, but **in childcare studies** the upper age limit generally used is 13 years





Ranking of European countries by childcare time




Time devoted to childcare by people employed living in couple with children* in European Countries



Among Europe, Italy is one of the countries in which employed parents spend more time caring for children





A focus on Childcare in Italy gender gap for type of activities



The "Childcare budget time" for partners living in dual earner couples with children* in Italy





Italian mothers respond to the different needs of children and most of their childcare time is devoted to physical care and supervision (60.5%)

While Italian fathers spend most of their childcare time to play with children (41.8%).

The gender gap in childcare is slowly decreasing: from 68.4% in 2002-2003 to 66.8% in 2008-09 (-1.6 percentage points), mainly due to the increasing contribution of fathers to children's play time.

Some final remarks

It is very important to detail the different types of CHILDCARE activities to conduct appropriate studies on this issue and the ICATUS seems to be very suitable for this group of activities.

Regarding **ADULT CARE** activities, is the European classification system (HETUS) to be adapted possibly by increasing the types of activities and absolutely **removing the voluntary** on this topic.

Warning!

The code <u>443 Waiting for/accompanying dependent</u> <u>adults or children</u>: it's ambiguous and problematic to assign to Childcare or to Adult care.
