Main tasks include:

 Taking stock, reviewing progress, challenges and emerging needs, and proposing actions to advance gender statistics at the international, regional and national levels.

The key task:

 Coordination of activities/programmes to reduce overburdening statistical offices, maximize synergies and resources for the advancement of gender statistics.

IAEG-GS



Inter-agency and Expert Group on Gender Statistics (IAEG-GS)

- was mandated by the UN Statistical Commission to (key tasks):
 - Serve as the coordination mechanism for the Global Programme on Gender Statistics
 - Provide guidance for the development of manuals and methodological guidelines for the production and use of gender statistics
 - Review gender statistics with the aim of establishing a minimum set of gender indicators.

Standards and Guidelines

- Finalization of ICATUS (UNSD)
- Power and decision-making in the household (UNECE)
- Measuring and monitoring the nexus between gender and the environment (UNEP, UNSD, Reg. Com.)
- Provide inputs to the methodology of indicators
