Background

Indicators

I. Education and participation:

- 1. % of active female participants in leadership/management structures female specific
- 2. % of out of school adolescents who participate in targeted programs sex disaggregation
- 3. % of persons of concern aged 6-13 enrolled in primary education sex disaggregation
- 4. % of persons of concern aged 14-17 enrolled in secondary education sex disaggregation

II. Documentation and civil status:

- 5. % of children under 12 months old who have been issued birth certificates by the authorities sex disaggregation
- 6. % of PoC registered on an individual basis sex disaggregation
- 7. % of UASC for whom a best interest process has been initiated or completed sex disaggregation
- 8. # of known cases of refoulement sex disaggregation

III. Health and living conditions:

- 9. Maternal mortality ratio female specific
- 10.% of women with sanitary supplies female specific
- 11.Under-5 mortality rate sex disaggregation
- 12.% of female-headed households living in adequate dwellings female specific

IV. Sexual and gender based violence:

13.# of reported incidents of SGBV per year - sex disaggregation



Deliverables

- Data management: tools for collecting and reporting gender disaggregated and female specific data.
- Guidance on analysis: how to interpret the evidence for women and girls.
