Summary**

The first edition of the “Toponymic guidelines for map editors and other editors, Republic of Korea” was published in June 2012. This is the first comprehensive version of a series of reports on the romanization of Korean geographical names. Based on the content template provided in working paper No. 86 of the twenty-sixth session of the United Nations Group of Experts on Geographical Names and suggestions made in working paper No. 29 of the twenty-fifth session of the Group, toponymic guidelines have been prepared both in English and Korean with an outline revised to accommodate the characteristics of Korean geographical names.
