The Ninth session of the Tenth United Nations linguistic/geographical division /Bratislava, March 1989/ appreciated the promptness of the Department of Technical Co-operation for Development in the implementation of the resolution 24 /Fifth United Nations Conference on the Standardization of Geographical Names, Montreal, August 1987/ recommending the issue of a semi-annual information bulletin - "UNGEGN Newsletter".

From member states of the Tenth United Nations linguistic/geographical division Bulgaria, Cyprus and Czechoslovakia have contributed to the bulletins. The distribution of the bulletins into some states of the linguistic/geographical division is not abundantly ensured.

The states participated at the Ninth session of the Tenth United Nations linguistic/geographical division settled on regular contributing to the bulletin and on the assertion of the claim for regular transmission on announced addresses.
