"COUNTRY NAMES"

The attached list shows the differences between Country Names as shown in United Nations *Terminology* (Bulletin No. 342, 1991) and those used by Canada, based upon recommendations from the Department of External Affairs to the Canadian Permanent Committee on Geographical Names.

Four general comments are offered on aspects of names standardization.

- (1) In the names of some countries we favour capitalization of the definite article and its inclusion as an integral part of the name.
 - (a) In English, we use "The", rather than "the", in: The Bahamas, The Comoros, The Congo, The Gambia, The Ivory Coast, The Netherlands, The Niger, The Philippines, Saint Vincent and The Grenadines, and The Sudan.
 - (b) In French, we capitalize the definite article in the common form of the name for: Les Bahamas, Les Bermudes, Les Comores, Les Maldives, Les Pays-Bas, Les Philippines, Les Seychelles, and Les Tonga.
- (2) If full official names of countries exist, we urge their inclusion in the UN list, e.g. Commonwealth of Australia, Republic of Ireland, Dominion of Canada.
- (3) When translations are made from the original language of a country name, we encourage the retention of the concepts and structure of the original language(s).

For example:

- (a) États-Unis mexicains rather than États-Unis du Mexique more faithfully follows the original Spanish form.
- (b) Most Serene Republic of San Marino (and Sérénissime République du Saint-Marin) are closer to the original concept in Italian than Republic of San Marino (and République du Saint-Marin).
- (c) Yugoslavia. Discrepancies between the English and French forms raise two questions:
 - (i) is the republic conceptually "federal" or "federative" ("fédérale" or "fédérative")?
 - (ii) the word order in English "Social Federal Republic" has a different sense from that in French "République socialiste fédérative" - which more closely reflects the original language(s) version?
- (4) For names without any long standing tradition in other languages, we encourage that the characteristics of the original language be retained, e.g. in English São-Tomé and Príncipe, or in French São Tomé-et-Príncipe.
