Arabic version of resolutions adopted at 11 United Nations Conferences on the Standardization of Geographical Names

Summary**

Following the Eleventh United Nations Conference on the Standardization of Geographical Names, the Working Group on Evaluation and Implementation, established under the United Nations Group of Experts on Geographical Names, and the National Geographic Information Institute of Korea worked to update the Arabic version of the document entitled "Resolutions adopted at the 10 United Nations Conferences on the Standardization of Geographical Names – 1967, 1972, 1977, 1982, 1987, 1992, 1998, 2002, 2007, 2012"¹¹ by including the resolutions adopted at the Eleventh United Nations Conference. They also reviewed the searchable Arabic database containing those resolutions. These efforts were aimed at disseminating knowledge and information related to the resolutions to Arabic-speaking Member States.

The following documents were used as references for the updated Arabic version: the Arabic and English² versions of the aforementioned document and the
