## Gazetteer of Finnish exonyms on the Internet

## Summary\*\*

In September 2018, the Institute for the Languages of Finland published on the Internet a gazetteer of Finnish exonyms recommended for use in standard Finnish (newspapers, textbooks, etc.). The list consists of about 2,000 exonyms with corresponding endonyms, in addition to the names in English, French and German and, in some cases, other languages. The online gazetteer (http://kaino.kotus.fi/ eksonyymit/).is an updated version of the printed gazetteer published in 2013. The online version contains a function for searching exonyms, endonyms and other language or by feature type or location of named places. Preliminary plans are under way to develop the gazetteer by adding composite names in which only the generic term has been translated and a map showing the location of the named places.
