## TOPONYMIC GUIDELINES FOR MAP EDITORS AND OTHER EDITORS

<u>In both English and French and their Portrayal on</u>

<u>Canadian federal government maps</u>

However, in Ontario there are now three incorporated places with both English and French official forms:

French River (town)
Rivière des Français (ville)

West Nipissing (town) Nipissing Ouest (ville)

The Nation (municipality) La Nation (municipalité)

In addition, Ontario has approved the dual name: Stoney Point/Pointe-aux-Roches (community) for an unincorporated place. The matter of presentation on maps has yet to be determined.

# (3) Names of features which are shared by two provinces

There are no changes to this section.

# (4) Federal lands in the provinces and territories

On federal government maps the names of federal lands are shown in both official languages on a bilingual map or in the appropriate language on a unilingual map. The types of names include: Department of National Defence entities - bases, station, and training areas; National Park entities - national parks and national historic sites; and Indian Reserves. However, in the CGNDB, Indian Reserve records are being converted from a dual name format to a single name with both English and French included in the generic. The only province converted, at this time, is Manitoba.

(a) old format in Manitoba Berens River Indian Reserve 13

Réserve indienne Berens River 13

(b) new format in Manitoba Berens River 13

No federal topographic maps are now in production for Manitoba. Mapping specifications will need to be revised for showing this new format for Indian Reserve names. Maps being compiled for jurisdictions where the records are still in the old format will continue to show the Indian Reserve names in the old dual format until the records have been converted to the new format.

## (5) Names of some undersea features

There are no changes to the information provided in 1996. However, these names are now included in the Canadian Geographical Names Data Base and may now be consulted on the CPCGN's web site at: <a href="http://geonames.NRCan.gc.ca">http://geonames.NRCan.gc.ca</a>.
