Conventional Gazetteer of the United States of America

Roger L. Payne (USA)

The National Gazetteer of the United States of America is presently available as a standard product only in digital form, and only by individual State, Commonwealth, or Territory. Publication of the conventional version, U.S. Geological Survey Professional Paper 1200, with each State, Commonwealth, Territory, and outlying area to be published as a separate volume, was suspended in 1992 because of other priorities requiring re-direction of personnel resources. Another conventional product titled Interim Gazetteer and available for each State, Commonwealth, and Territory has also been discontinued. The availability of these products in digital form, and available for downloading at the Internet site of the Geographic Names Information System (GNIS) of the United States (<http://mapping.usgs.gov/www/gnis>) has most likely contributed to an overall decline in requests for the conventional listings. The rate of retrieval of gazetteers in this digital format is averaging more than 100 per day; therefore, the conventional gazetteer will be available as a "print on demand item" only.
