Thursday, 5 September 2002

8th meeting

Consideration of draft report

The Conference reviewed the d raft report and agreed on the final text.

9th meeting

Adoption of resolutions drafted during the Conference [20]

The Conference began its consideration of the item and adopted document E/CONF.94/L.3, containing 17 draft resolutions of the Conference.

Adoption of the report of the Conference [21]

The Rapporteur introduced the draft report contained in document E/CONF.94/L.2, and reports of Committee I, II, and III, as amended and the draft resolutions of the Conference, contained in E/CONF.94/L.3, as amended.

Before the adoption of the draft report, the representative of France made a comment.

The Conference adopted the draft report and authorized the Rapporteur, in consultation with the Secretariat, to complete the report, with a view to its submission to the Economic and Social Council.

Closing of the Conference [22]

The President made a concluding statement and declared the Eighth United Nations Conference on the Standardization of Geographical Names closed.

A statement was made by the representative of Sudan.
