Summary

Since the 28th session of the United Nations Group of Experts on Geographical Names (UNGEGN), the activities of French-speaking Division have mainly been based on the decisions made at the Division meeting on April 30, 2014, in New York.

The key decisions discussed involved:

- Division operations;
- Development of a work program;
- Annual publication of the Bulletin d'information toponymique;
- Sharing of national activity reports;
- Completion of a French toponymy distance course;
- Participation of experts in UNGEGN's work.

Because the Division was working through email, it was possible to comply with these points.

However, although experts were able to hold discussions during a number of meetings, the Division itself was not able to meet between the 28th and 29th sessions.

In accordance with the request of the UNGEGN Secretariat, the French-speaking Division received a number of country reports.
